Monthly report (September 2021)**

1. 1st, 2nd & 3rd September (wed.,thu.,fri):

B.P.Ed. Sem IV practical exams were held on college ground. Offline exams were held long after 18 months as only online mode was permitted due to covid outbreak. The students as well as teachers were enthusiastic for the conduction of exam. The exams were held in two sessions i.e. morning 6:30 am. To 10:30 am and evening 3:30 pm. To 6:00 pm.



2. 4th September (Saturday):

A farewell function was held for the students of B.P.Ed. II (Sem IV) students. Teacher's day was also celebrated on the occasion. Scholarships to students with maximum attendance were awarded by the hands of chief guest Dr. Prasad Karandikar.
