Monthly report (January 2022)**

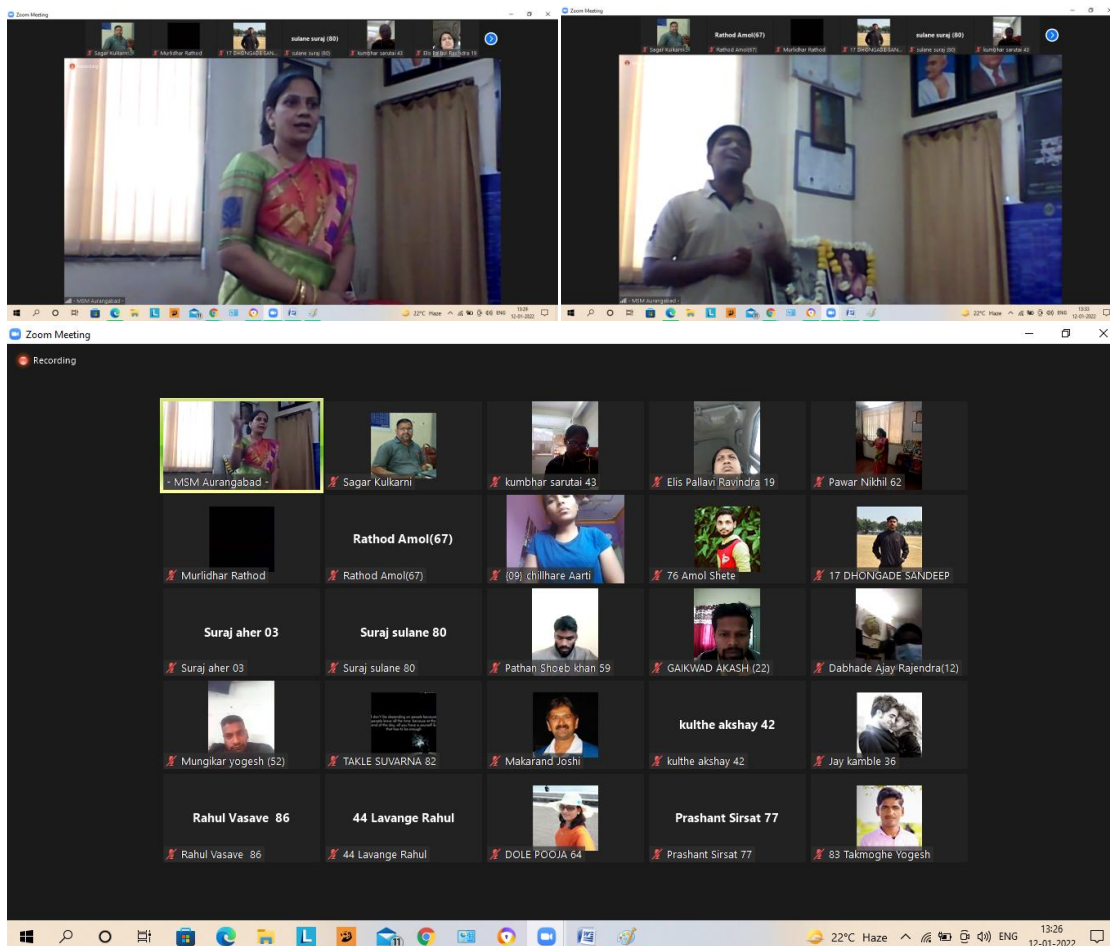
1. 3rd January (Monday) Savitribai Phule Jayanti :

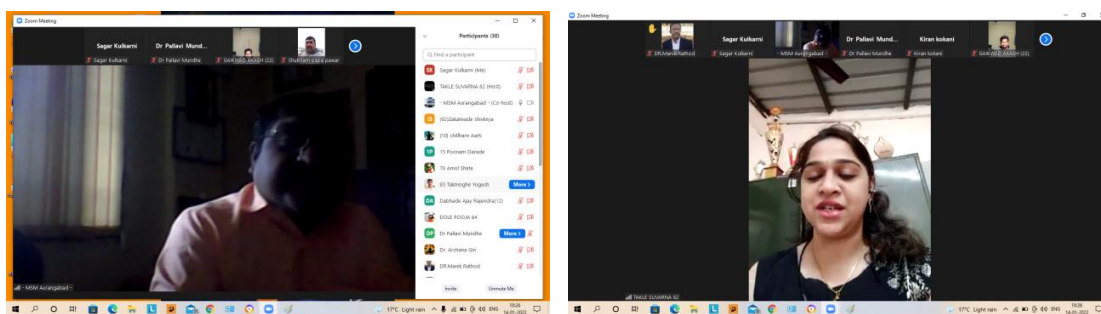
2. 12th January (Wednesday) Rajmata Jijau and Swami Vivekanand Jayanti:

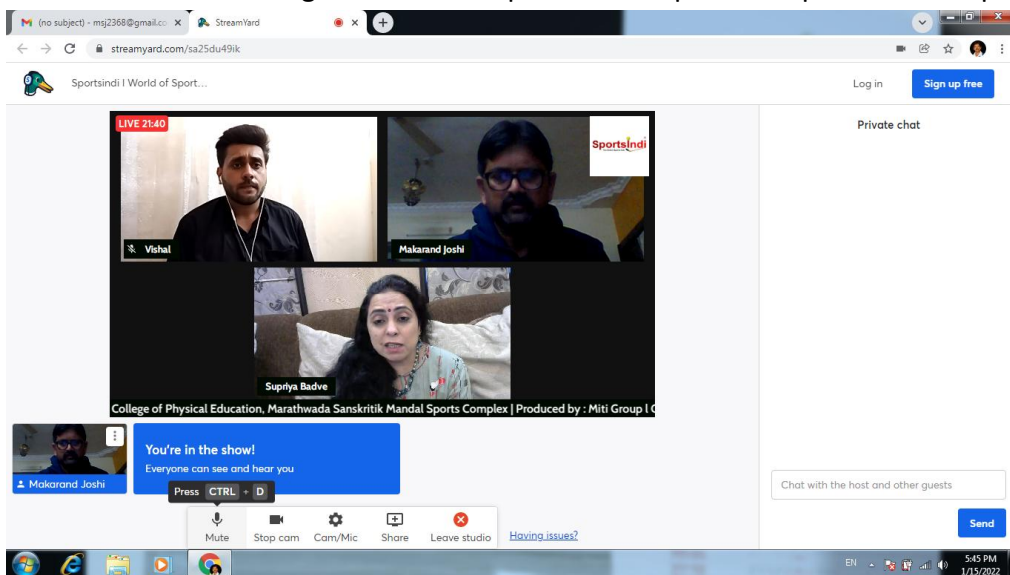
3. 14th January (Friday) Vidyapeeth Namvistar Din:

Eight students of B.P.Ed. II year participated in the event. The following is the list of participants and poems presented by them.

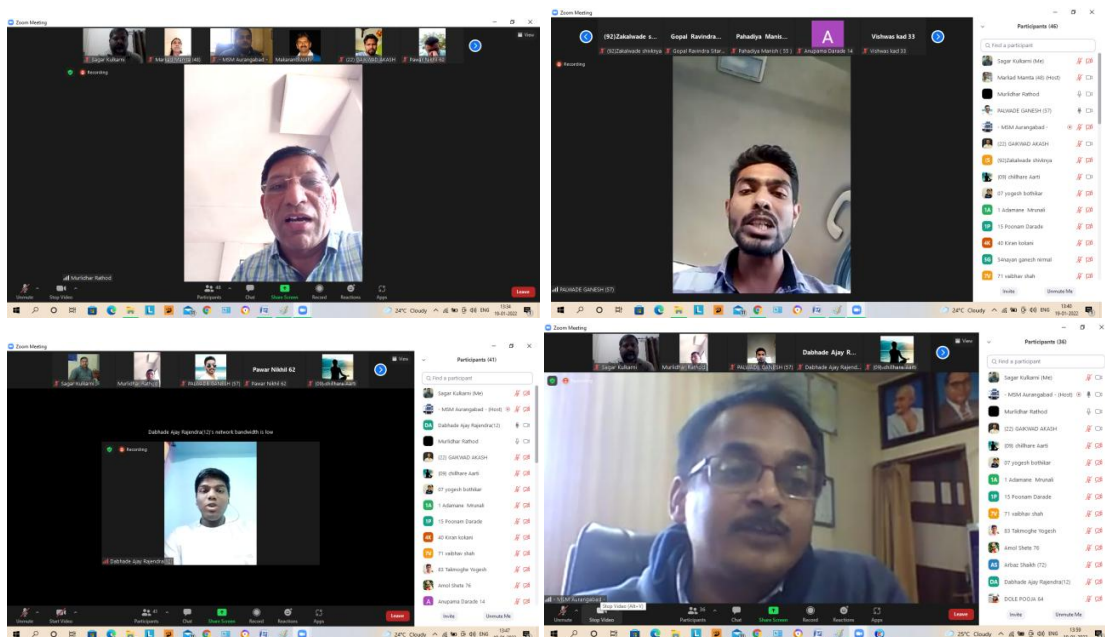

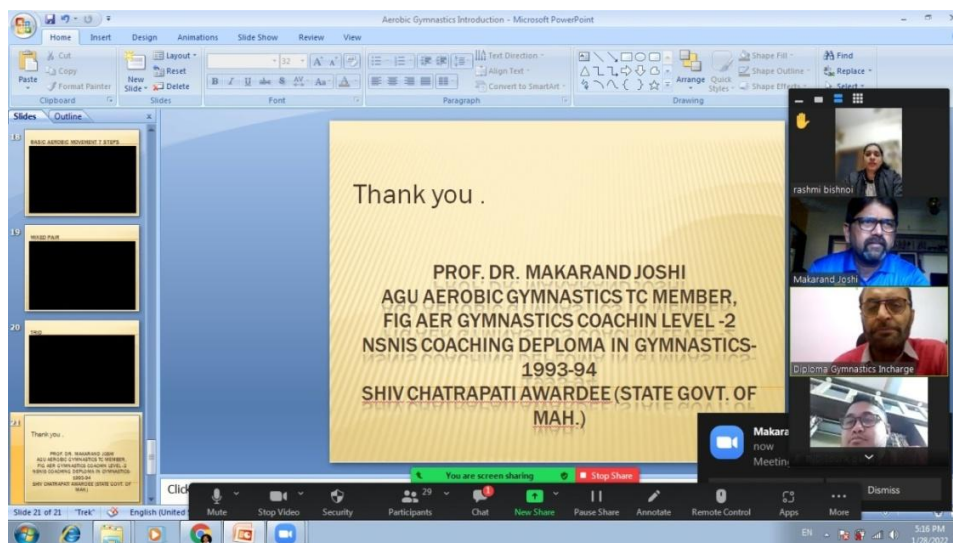






7. 28th January (Friday) faculty as resource person:
