1. 20th July (Organization of Certificate course by IQAC):

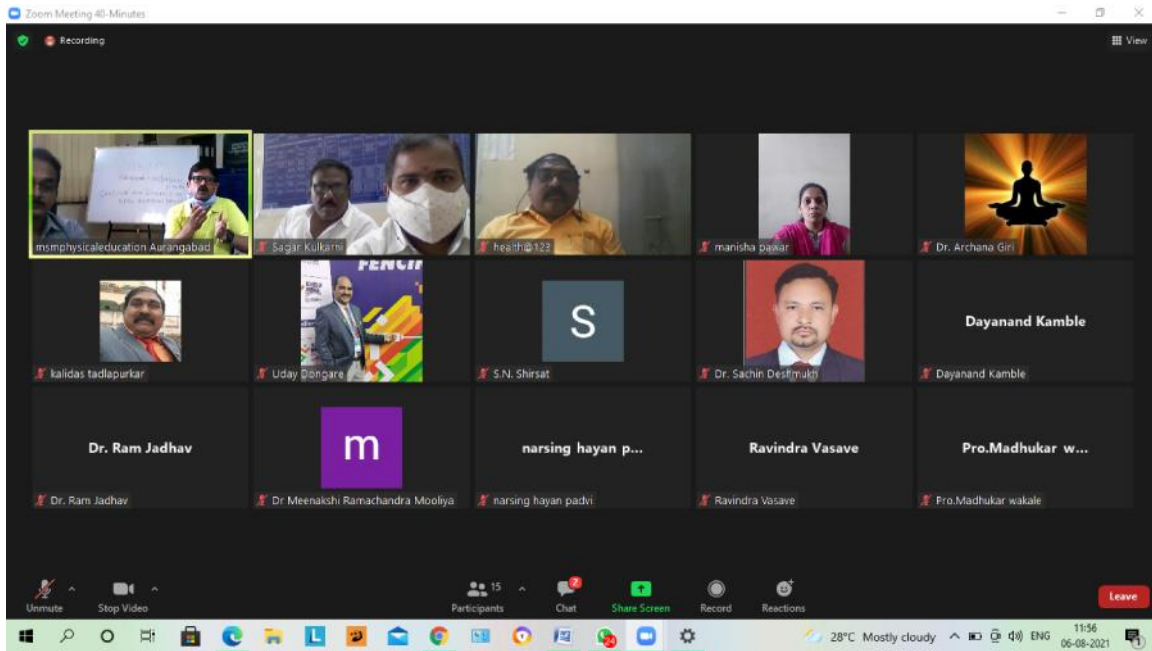

2. 4th September (Saturday) Farewell function:

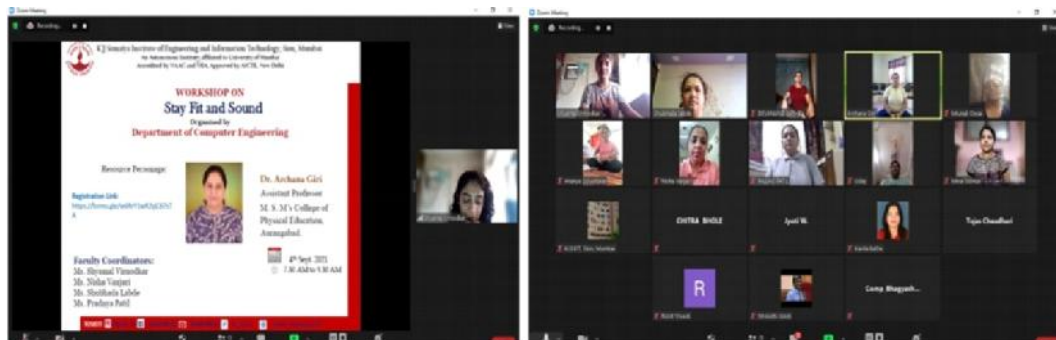

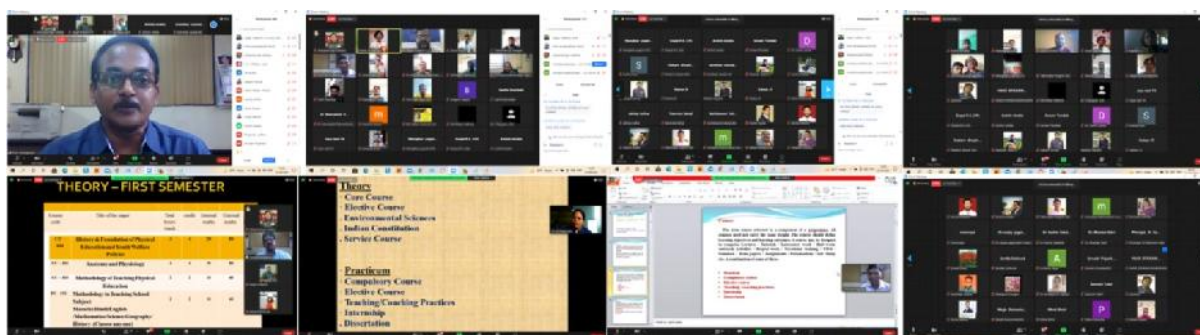
7. 22nd September (Wednesday) Guest visit:

8. 25th Setember, 2021 (One day E- Workshop on Revised syllabus):

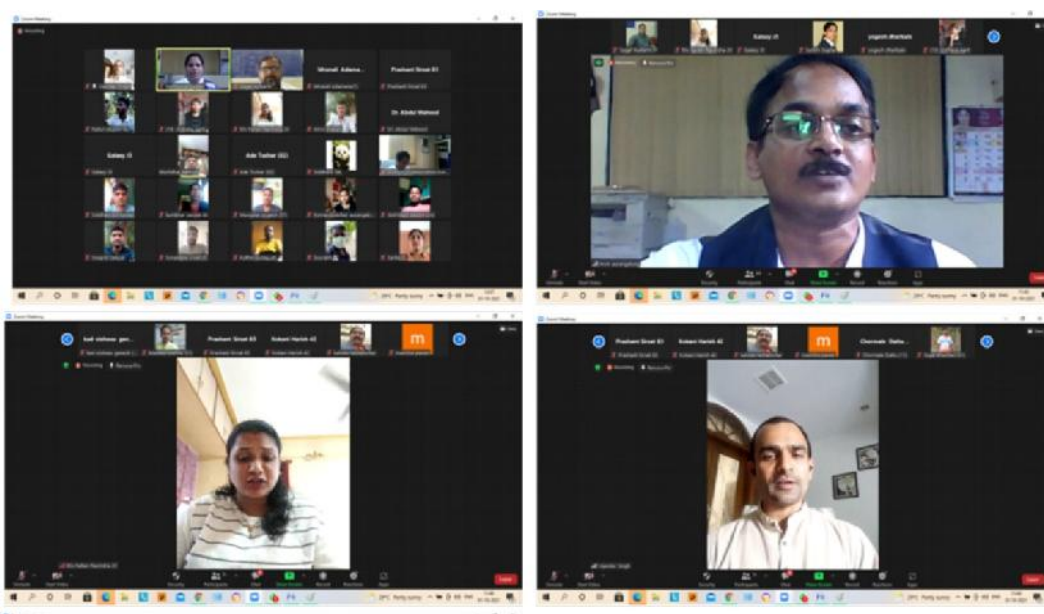

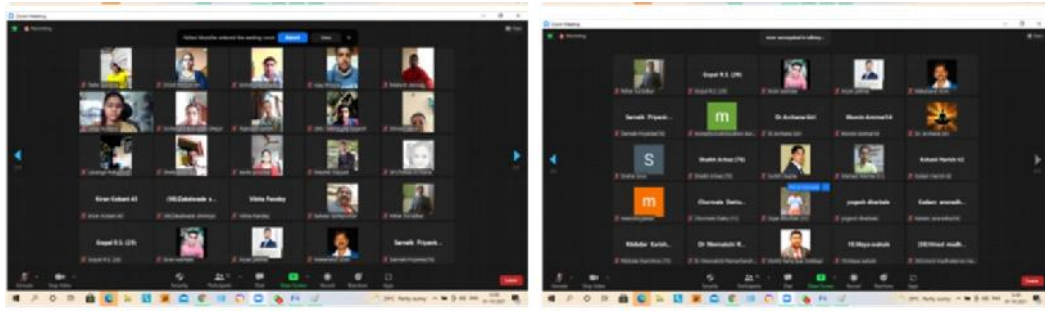

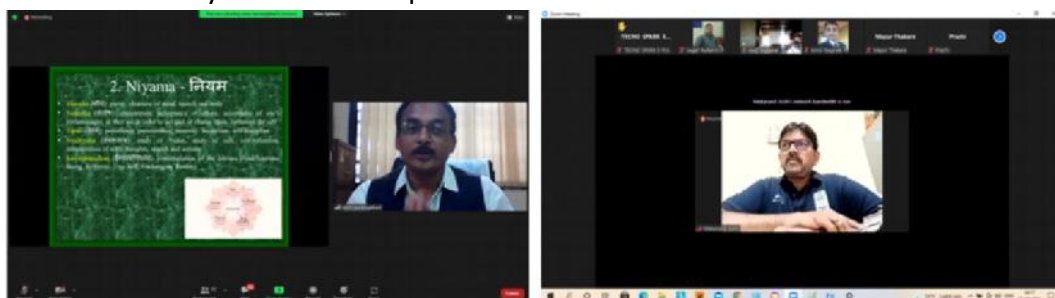
3. 5th October (Tuesday) Felicitation on Dr. R.K. Badawane:

5. 26th November(Friday) Constitution day:

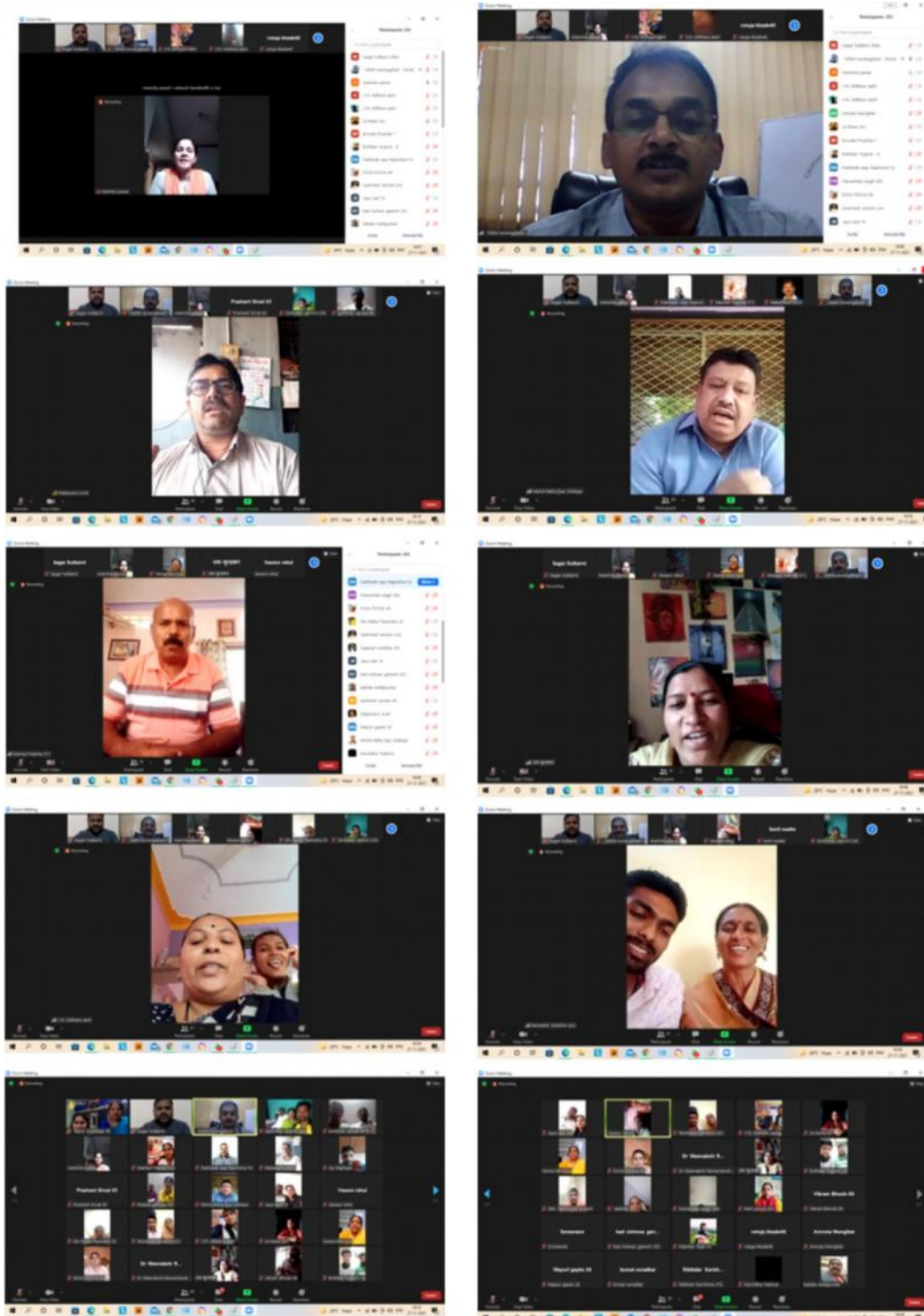

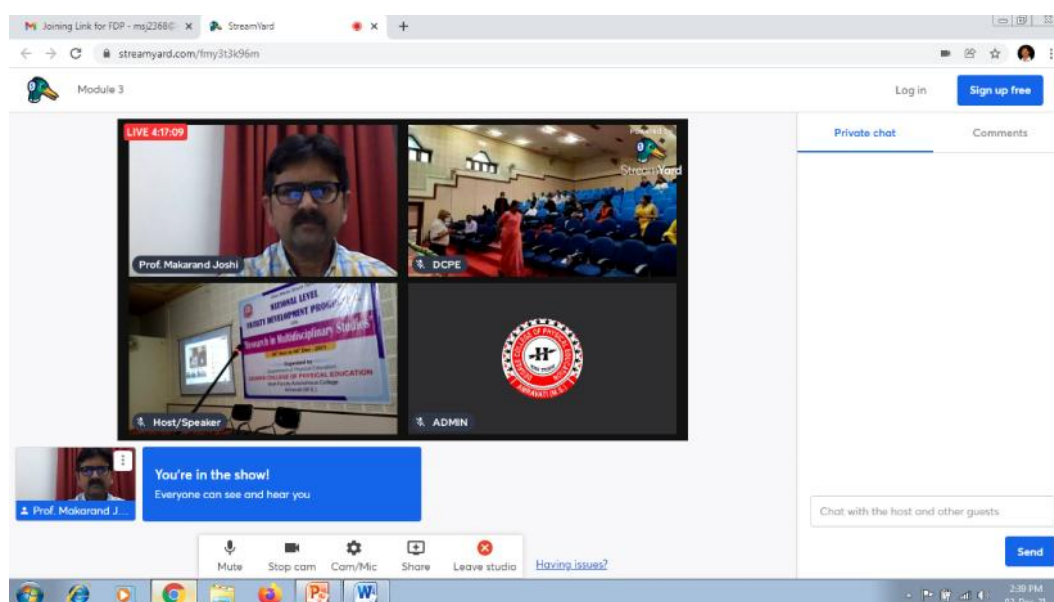

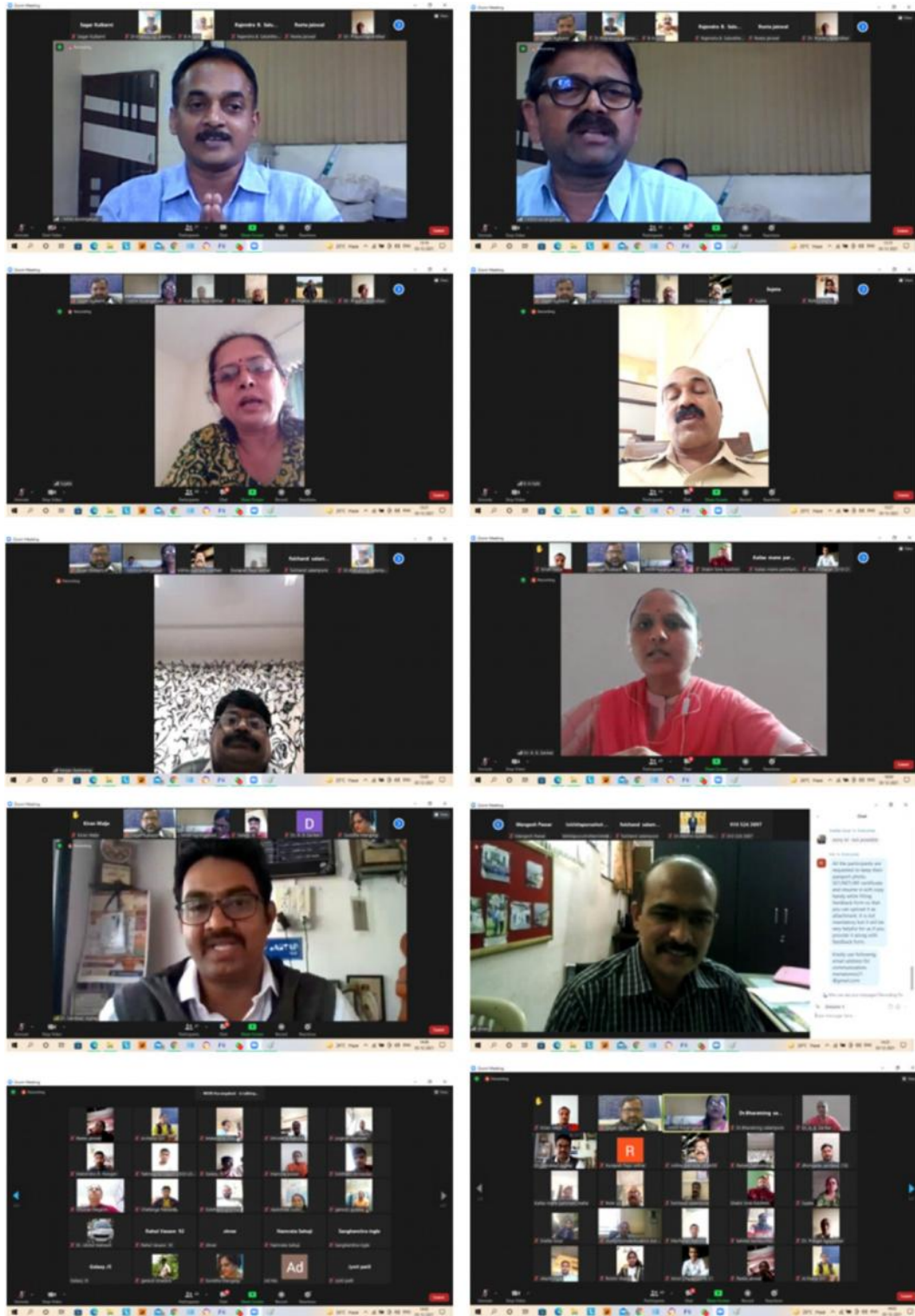
3. 2nd December, Thursday (Prof. Dr. S.M. Kote as Committee member):

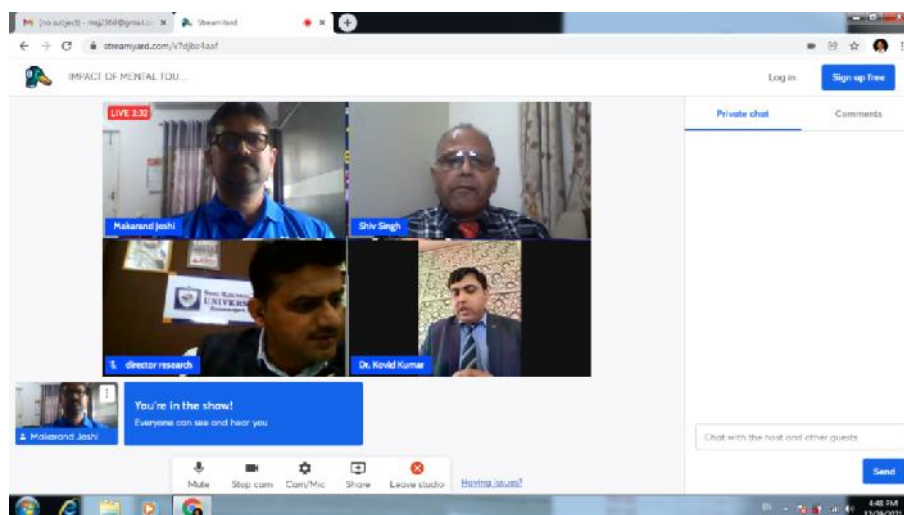
9. 23rd December (Thursday) ICT Gymnastics and Mallakhamb:

1. 4th February (Friday) Alumni achievement:

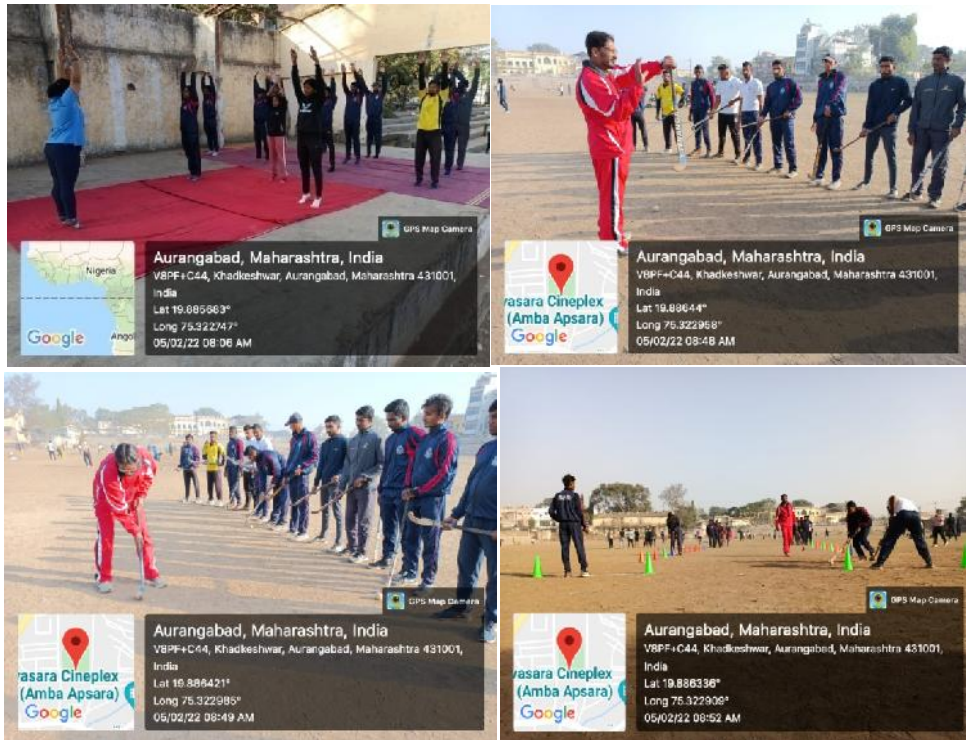

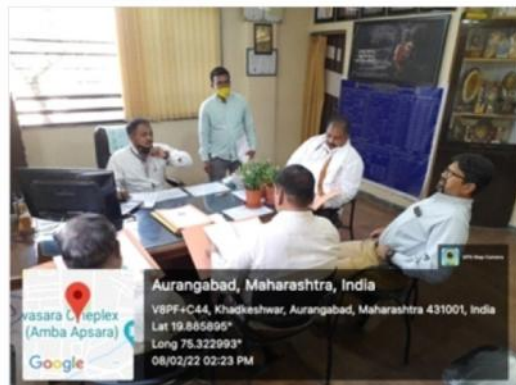

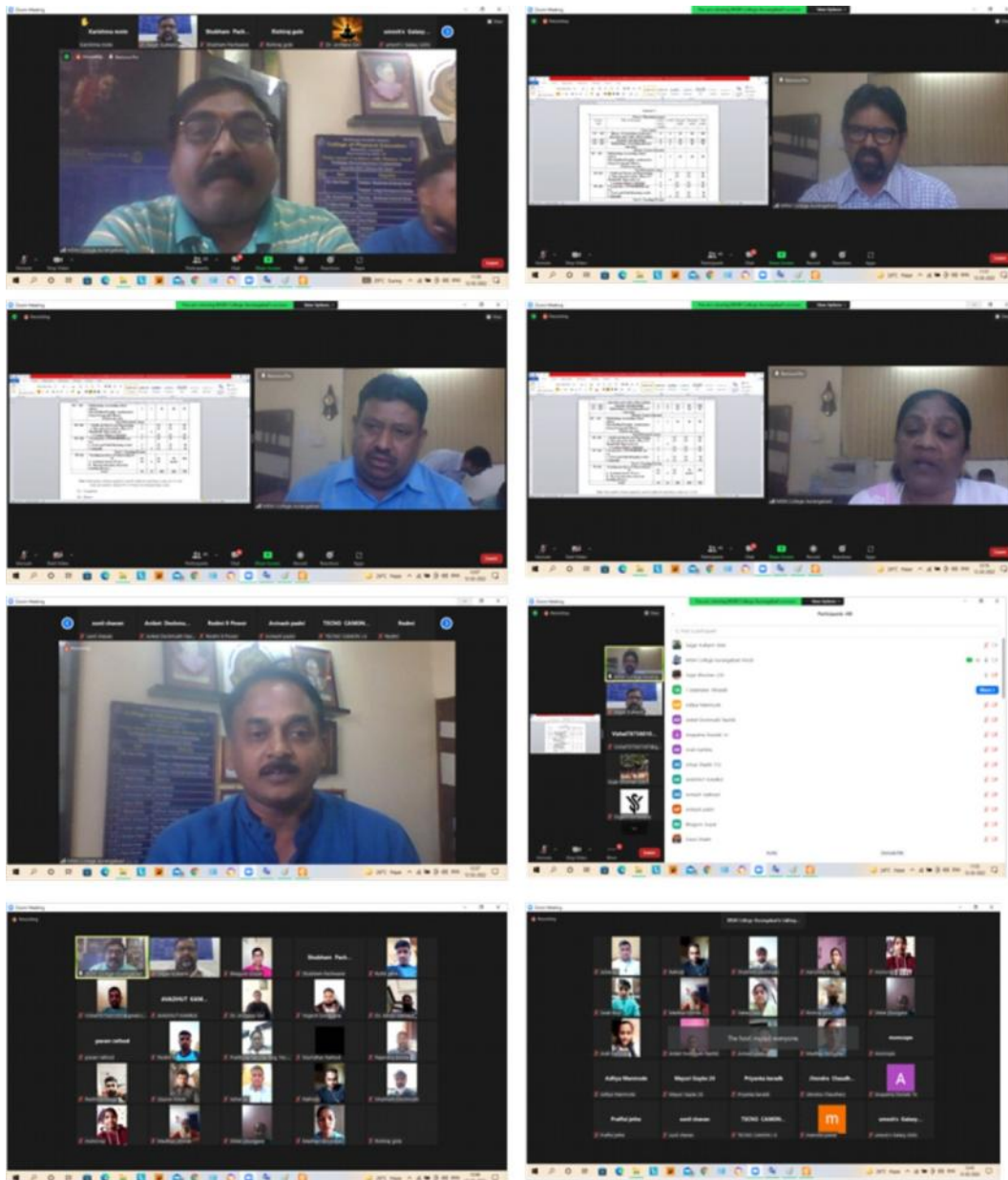
4. 11th February (Friday) Student achievement :

6. 19th April(Tuesday) Ph.D. Viva Voce exam of faculty member Sagar Kulkarni:

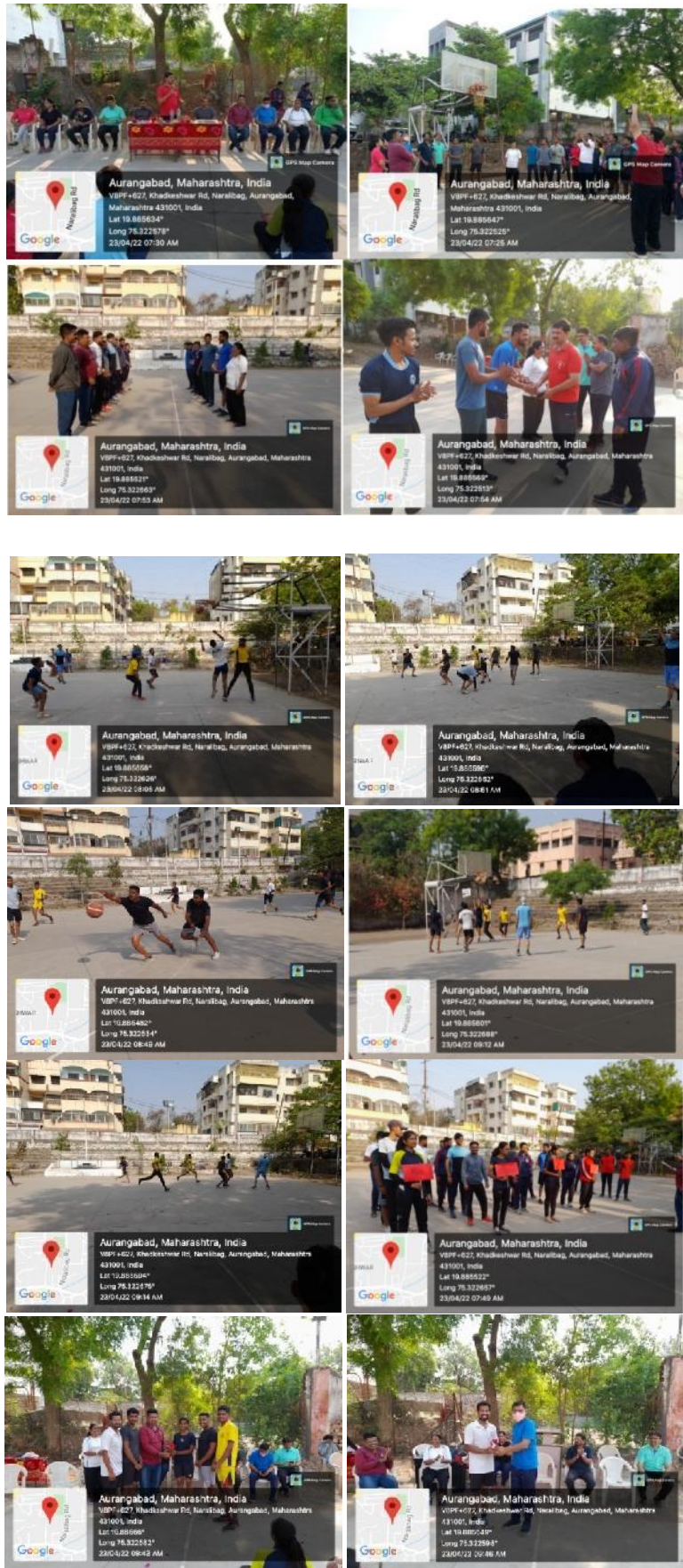

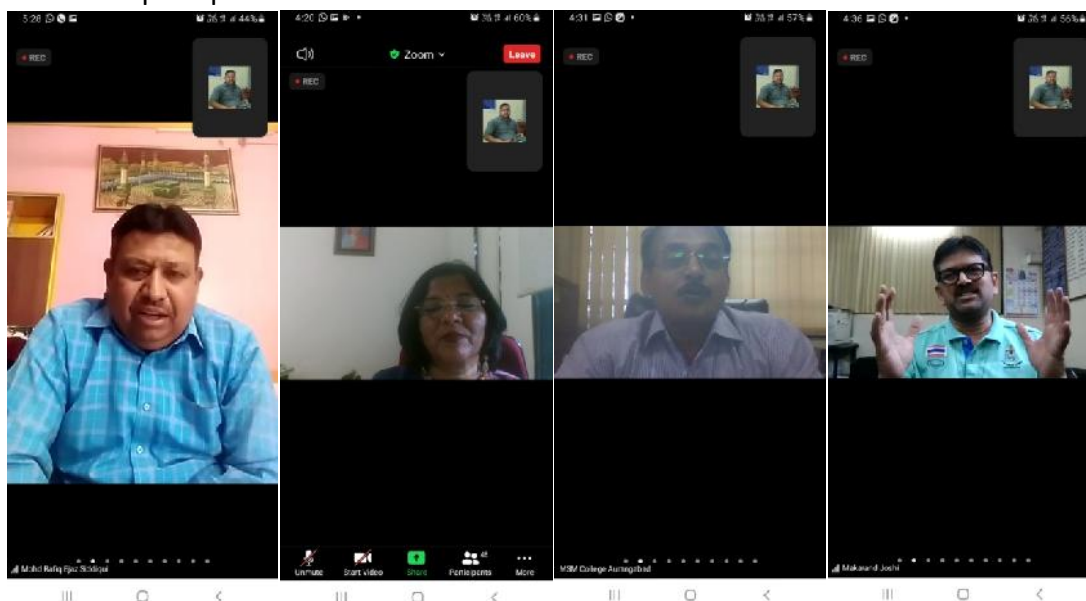
7. 23rd April (Saturday) Intramural sports:

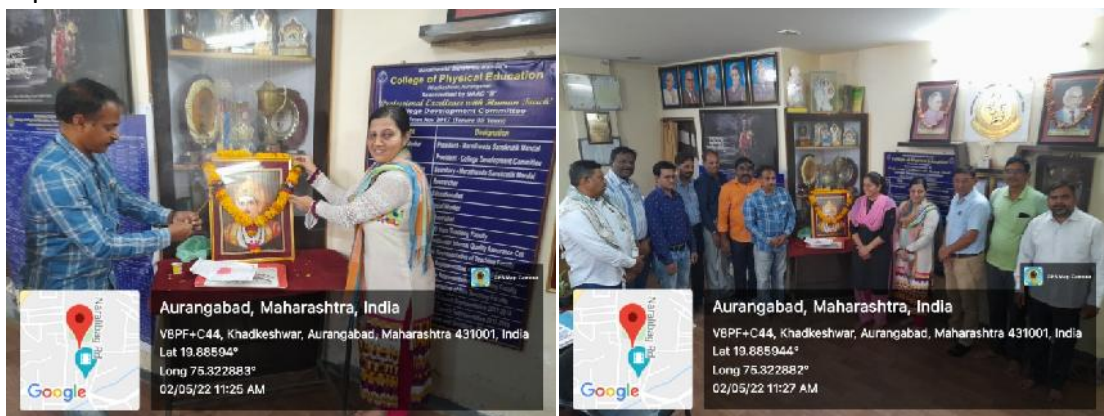
1. 1st May (Sunday) Maharashtra Din:

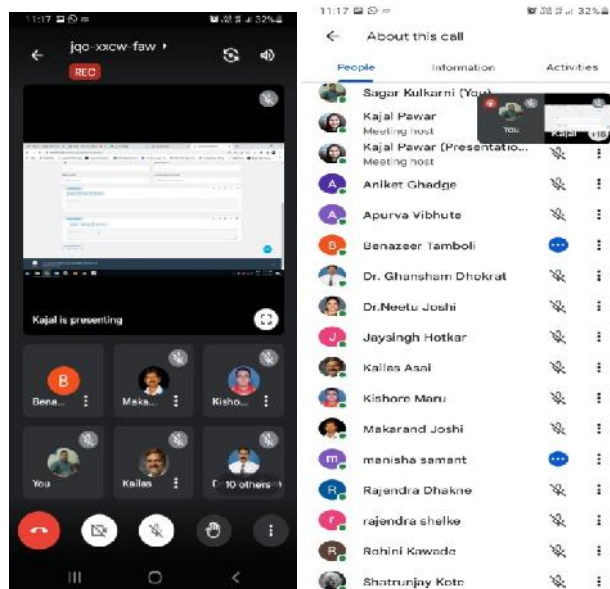
6. 18th to 23rd May (Wednesday to Monday) Faculty achievement as international official:
