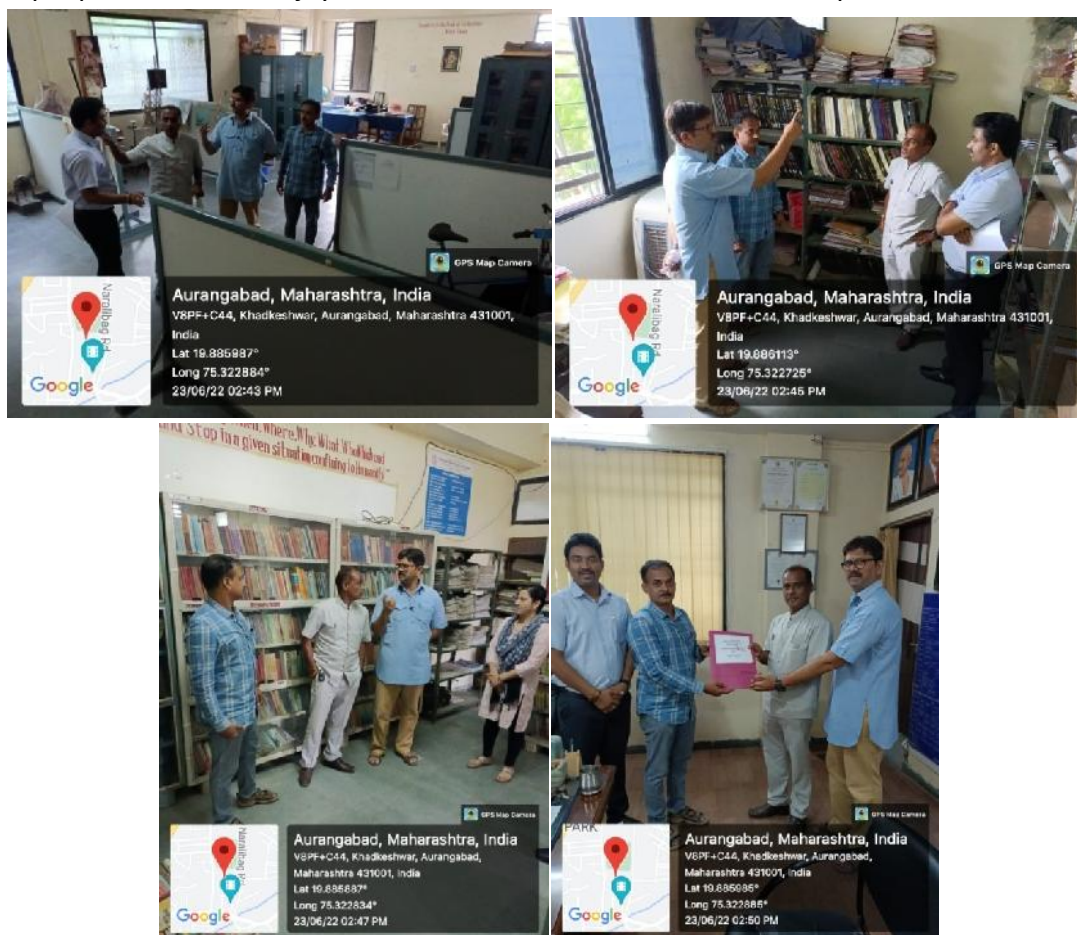
### 3. 21<sup>st</sup> June, Tuesday (International day of Yoga):

## Monthly report - July 2022

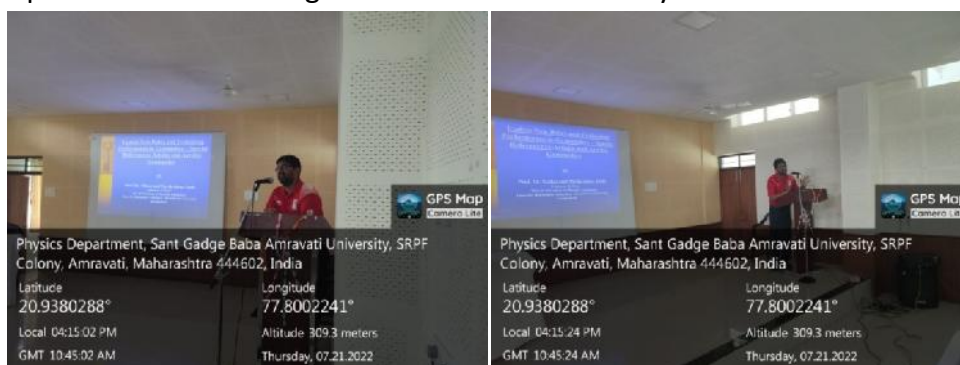
### 1. Wednesday, 13<sup>th</sup> July (Anti drug addiction awareness program):

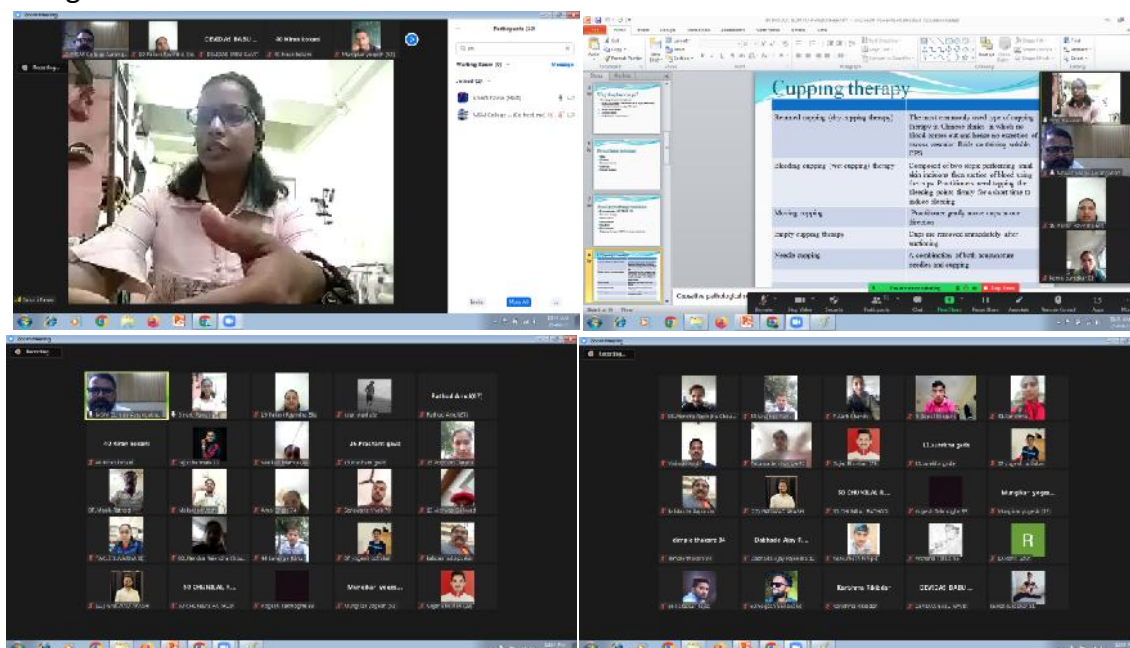
### 3. Saturday, 23<sup>rd</sup> July (Lokmanya Bal Gangadhar Tilak Jayanti):

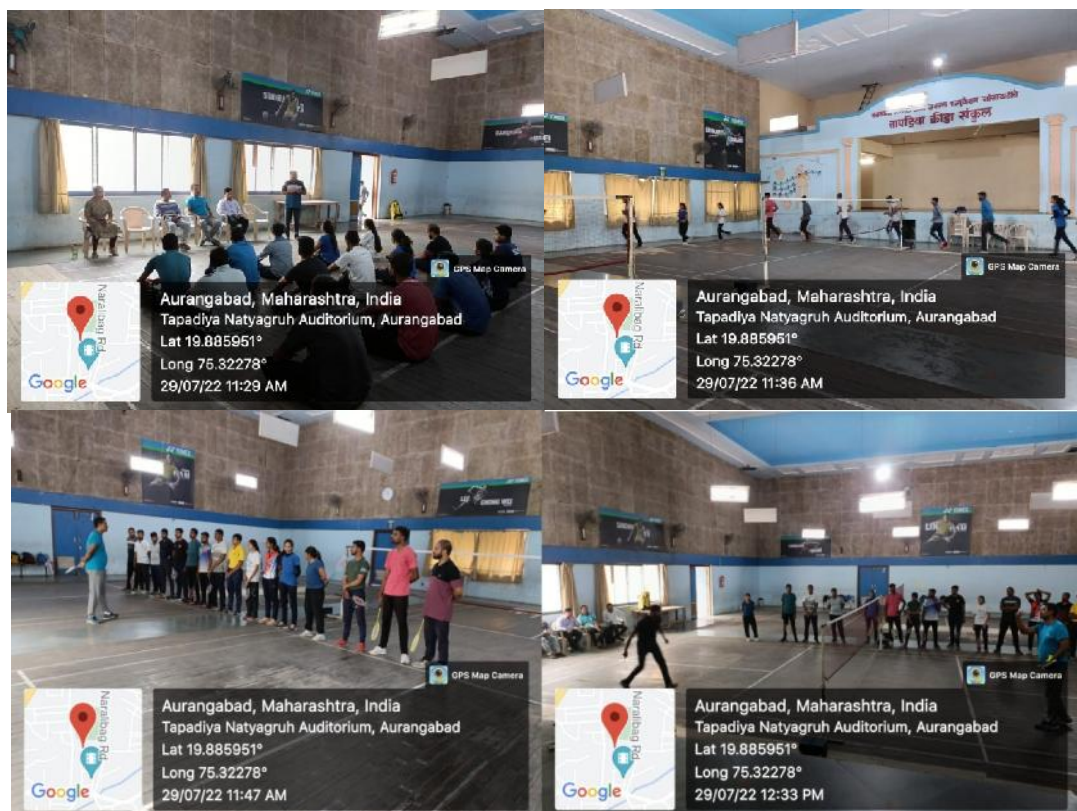
## 5. Friday, 29<sup>th</sup> July (Campus cleaning drive):

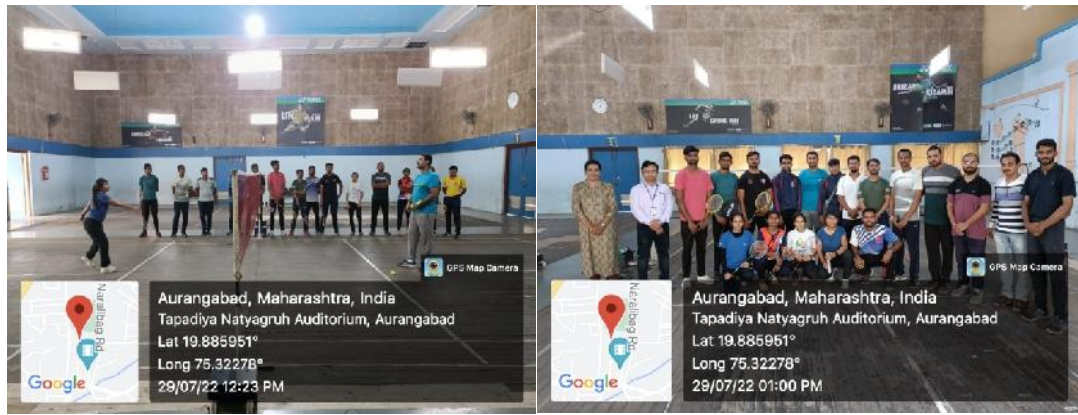
Campus cleaning drive was organized and grounds were cleaned by staff and students in morning as well as evening sessions. All faculty members were involved in the cleaning drive.

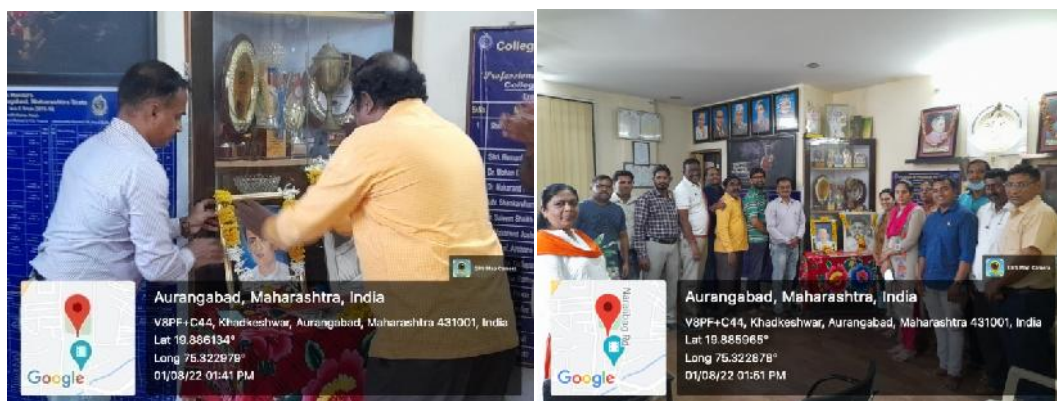
## 7. Student achievements:

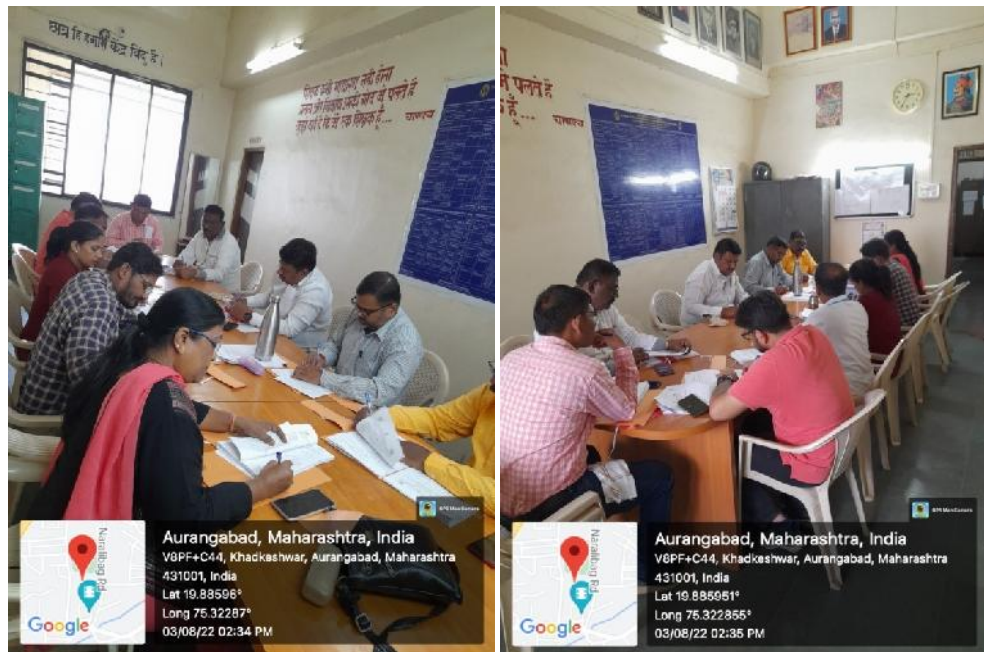
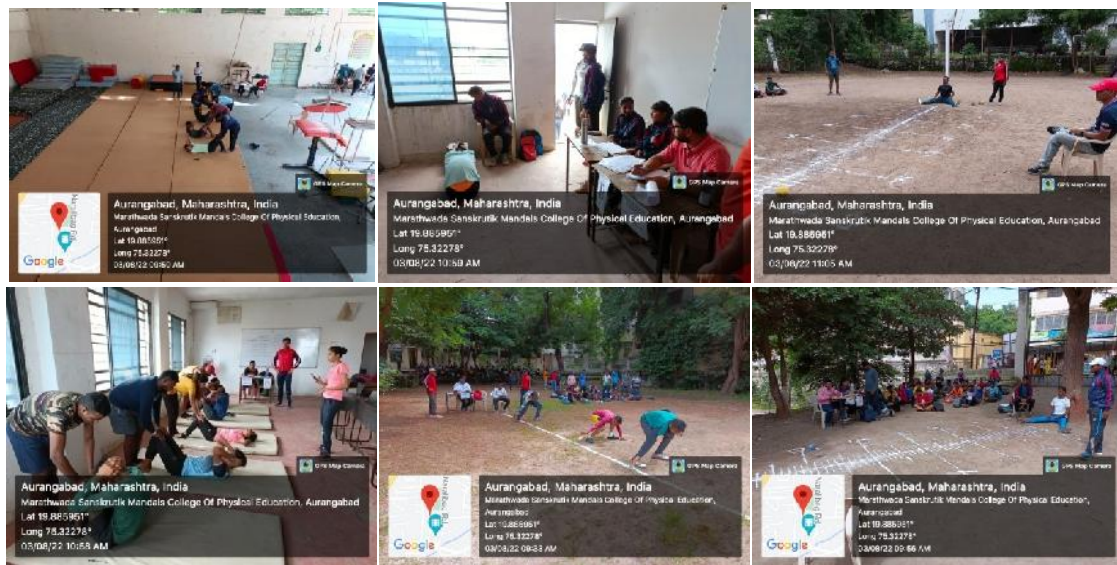
### 3. Tuesday, 2<sup>nd</sup> August (Felicitation of Athletic officials):

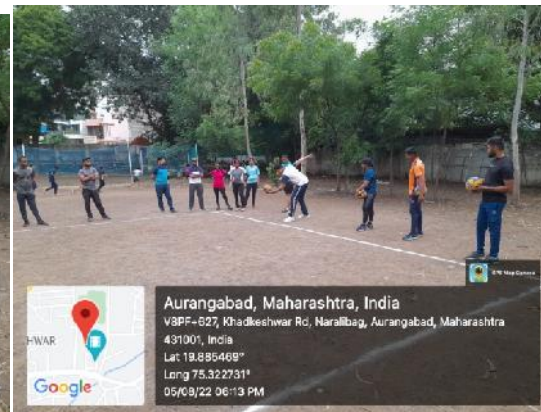
#### 4. Wednesday, 3<sup>rd</sup> August (B.P.Ed. CET field tests):

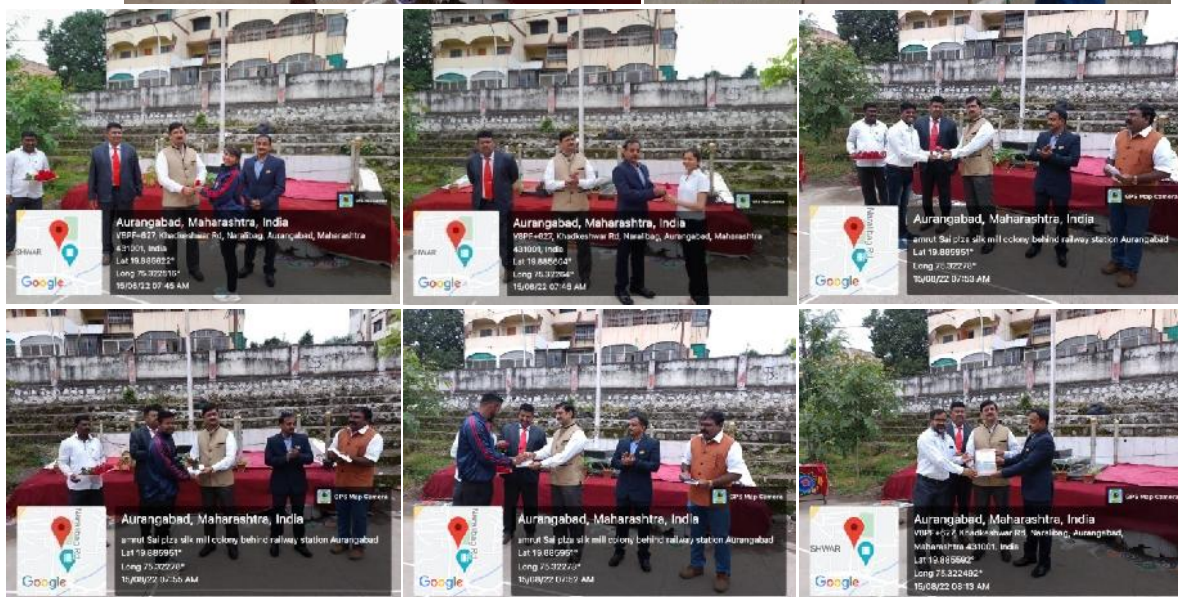

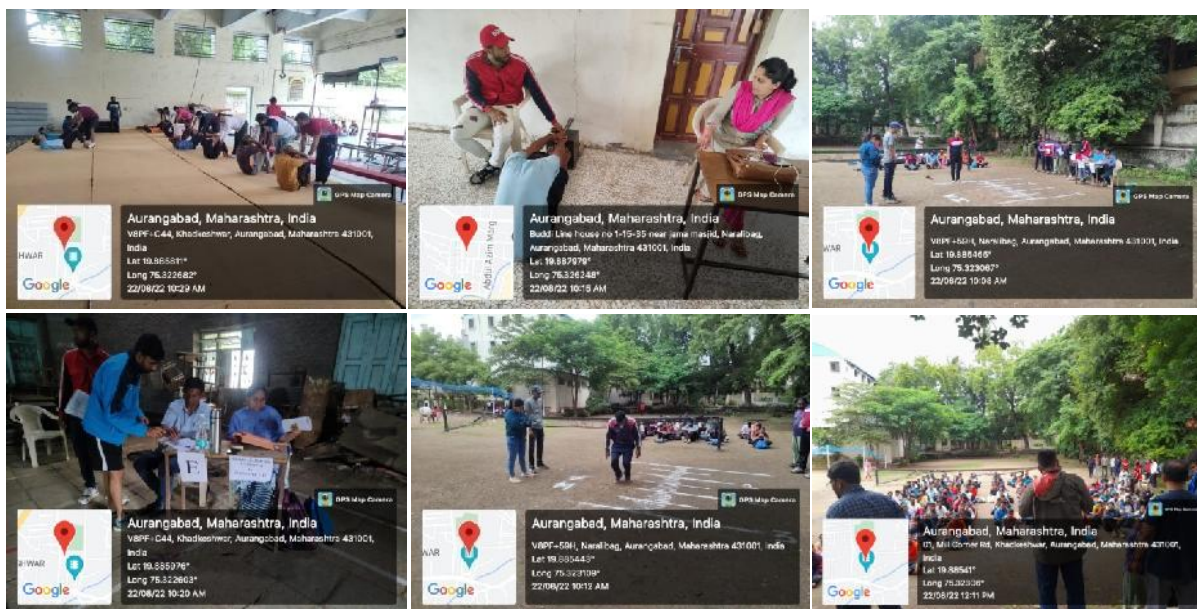

9. **Monday, 22<sup>nd</sup> August (M.P.Ed. CET):**

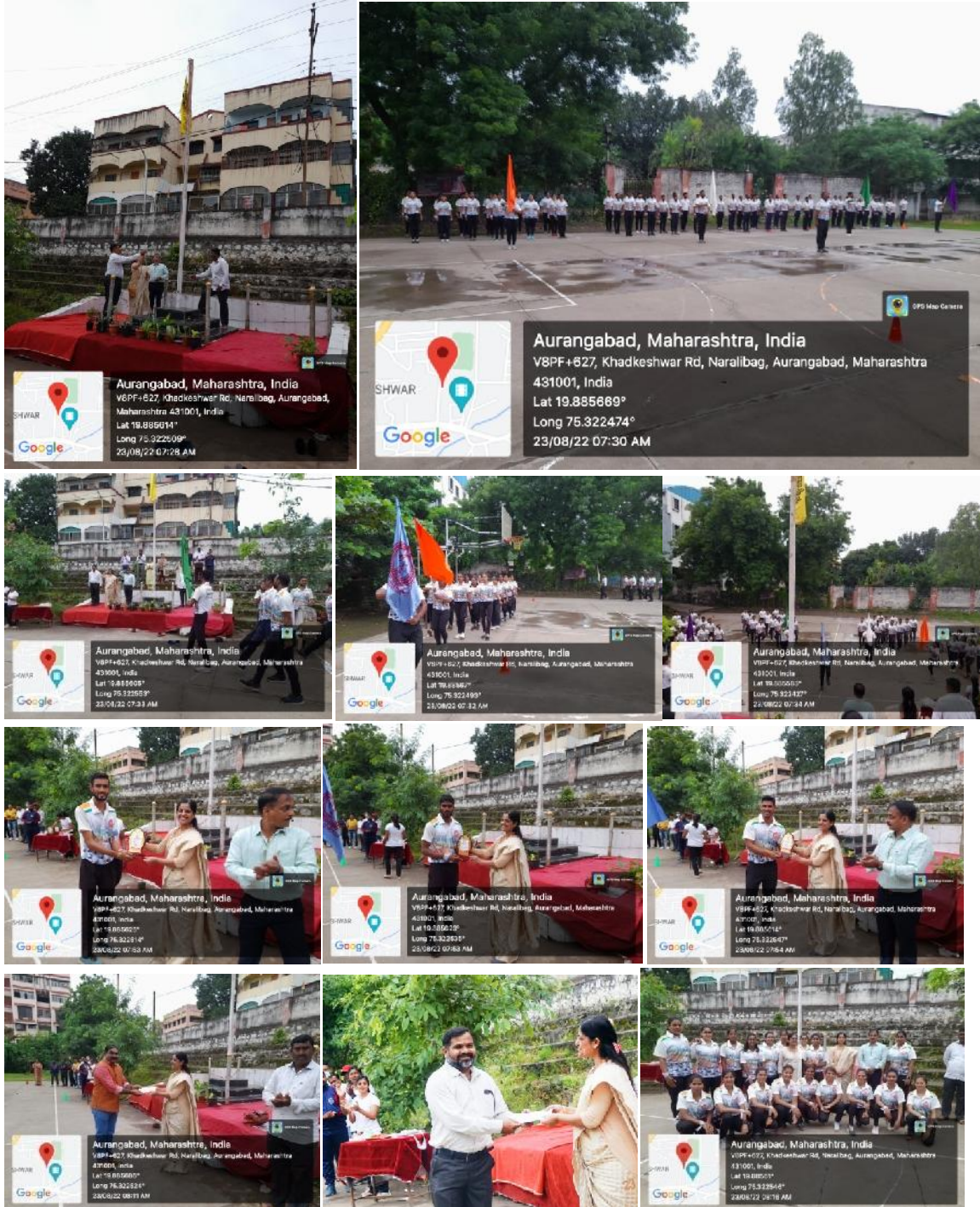
M.P.Ed. CET was conducted as per the directions by the state government CET cell from 7:00 am. to 3:00 pm.



10. **Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> August (University Foundation day):**

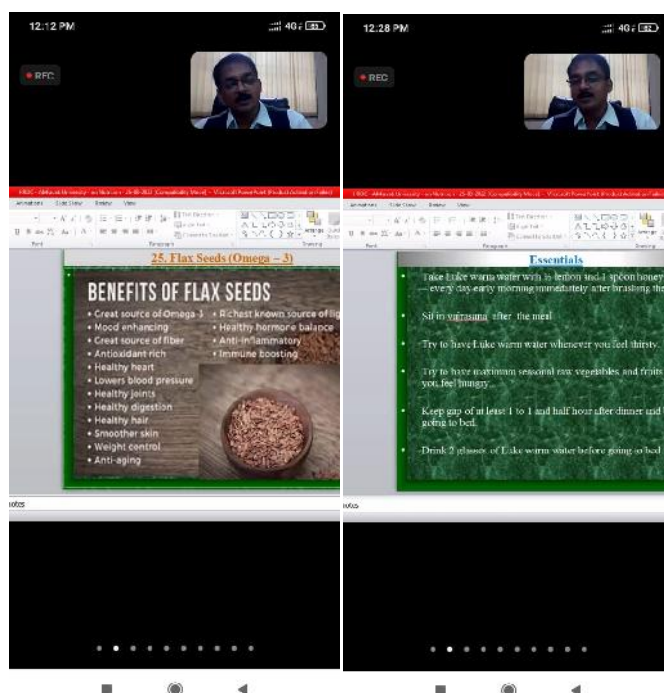

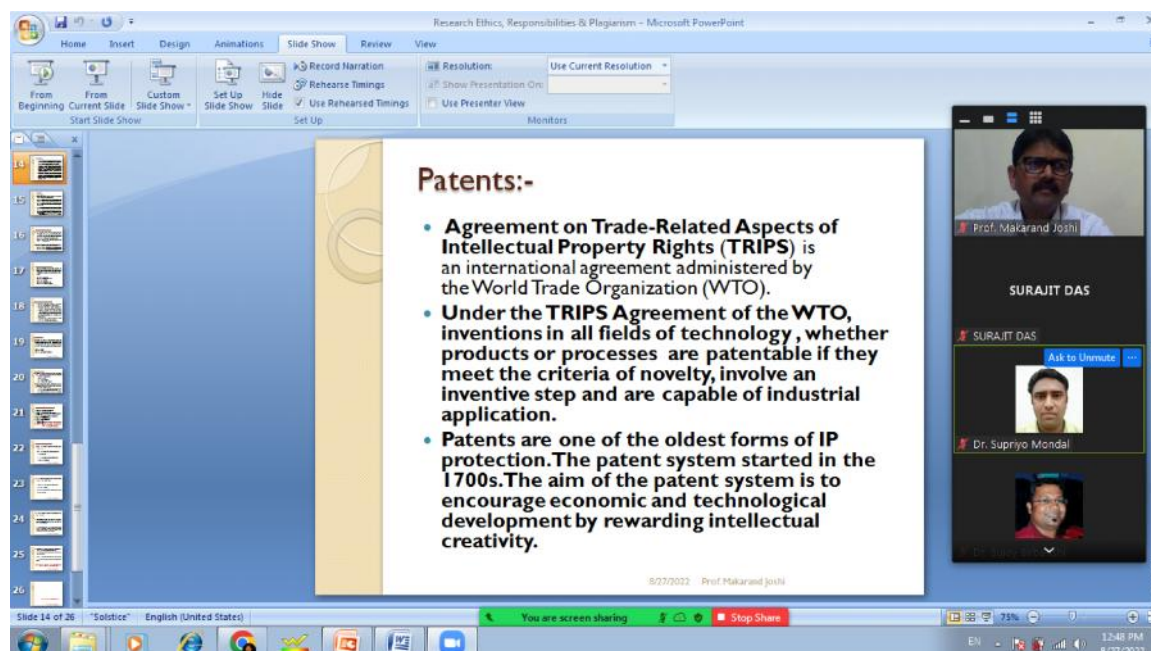
## 11. Friday, 26<sup>th</sup> August (Faculty as resource person):

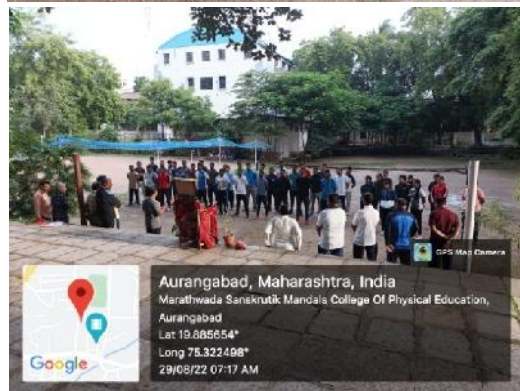
## 12. Saturday, 27<sup>th</sup> August (Faculty as resource person):

### 1. Monday, 5<sup>th</sup> September (Teacher's day):

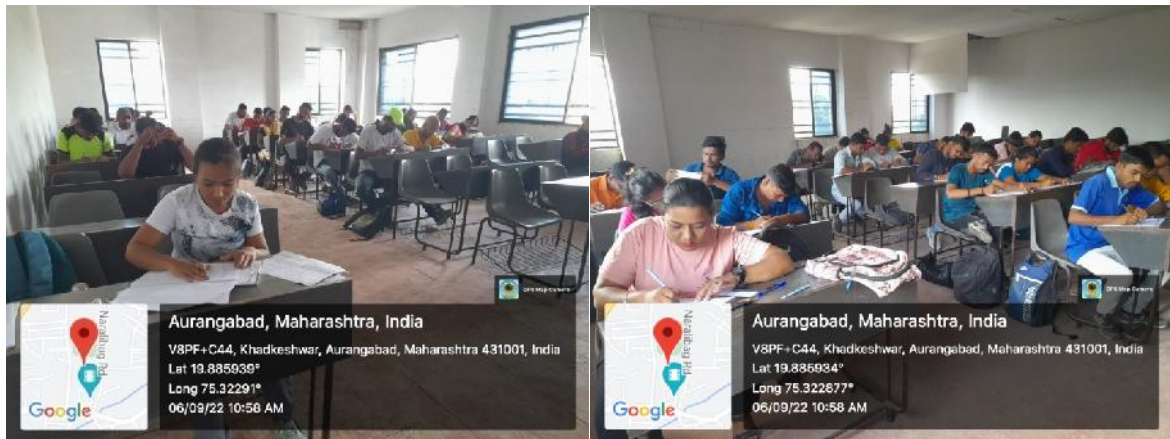

### 3. Monday, 14<sup>th</sup> November (Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru and Ustad Lahuji Salve Jayanti):

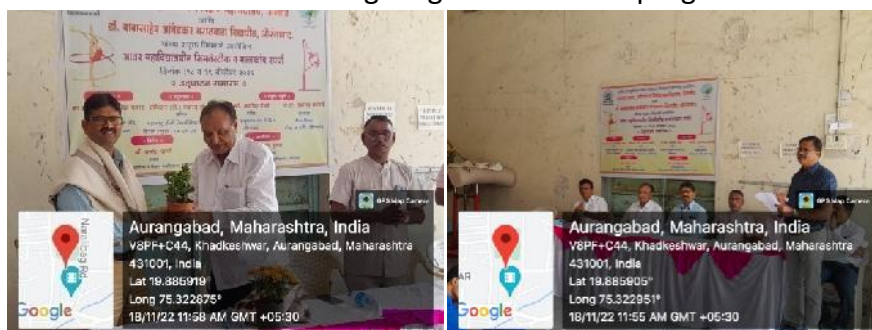

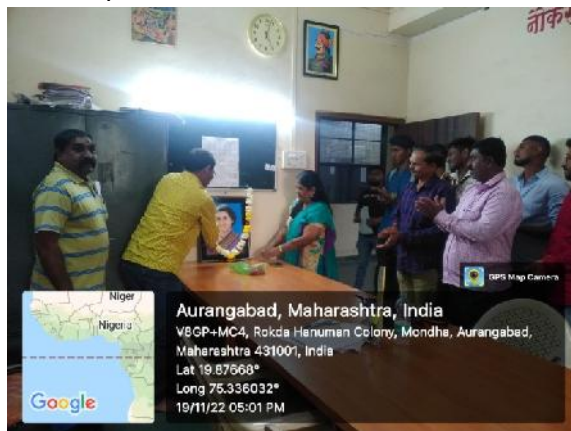
### 4. Friday, 18<sup>th</sup> November (Inter-collegiate competition opening ceremony):

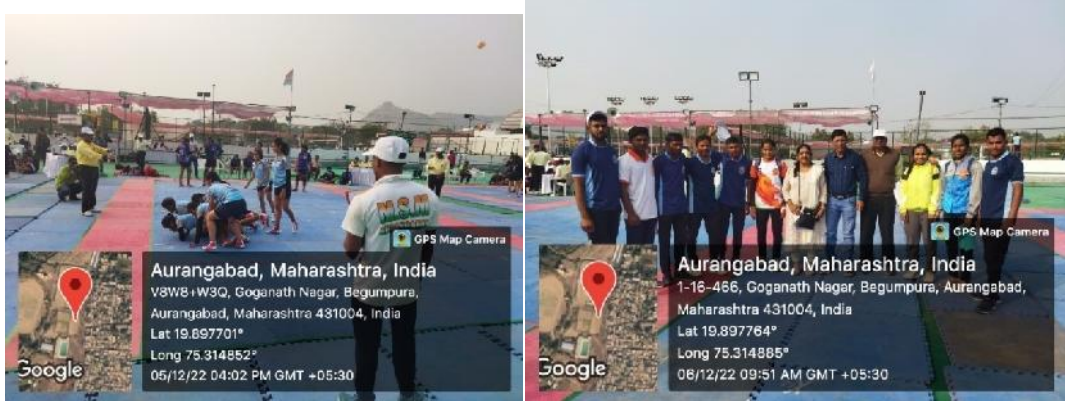

**4. Sat. to Tue. , 10<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> December (Physical education lessons on field):**

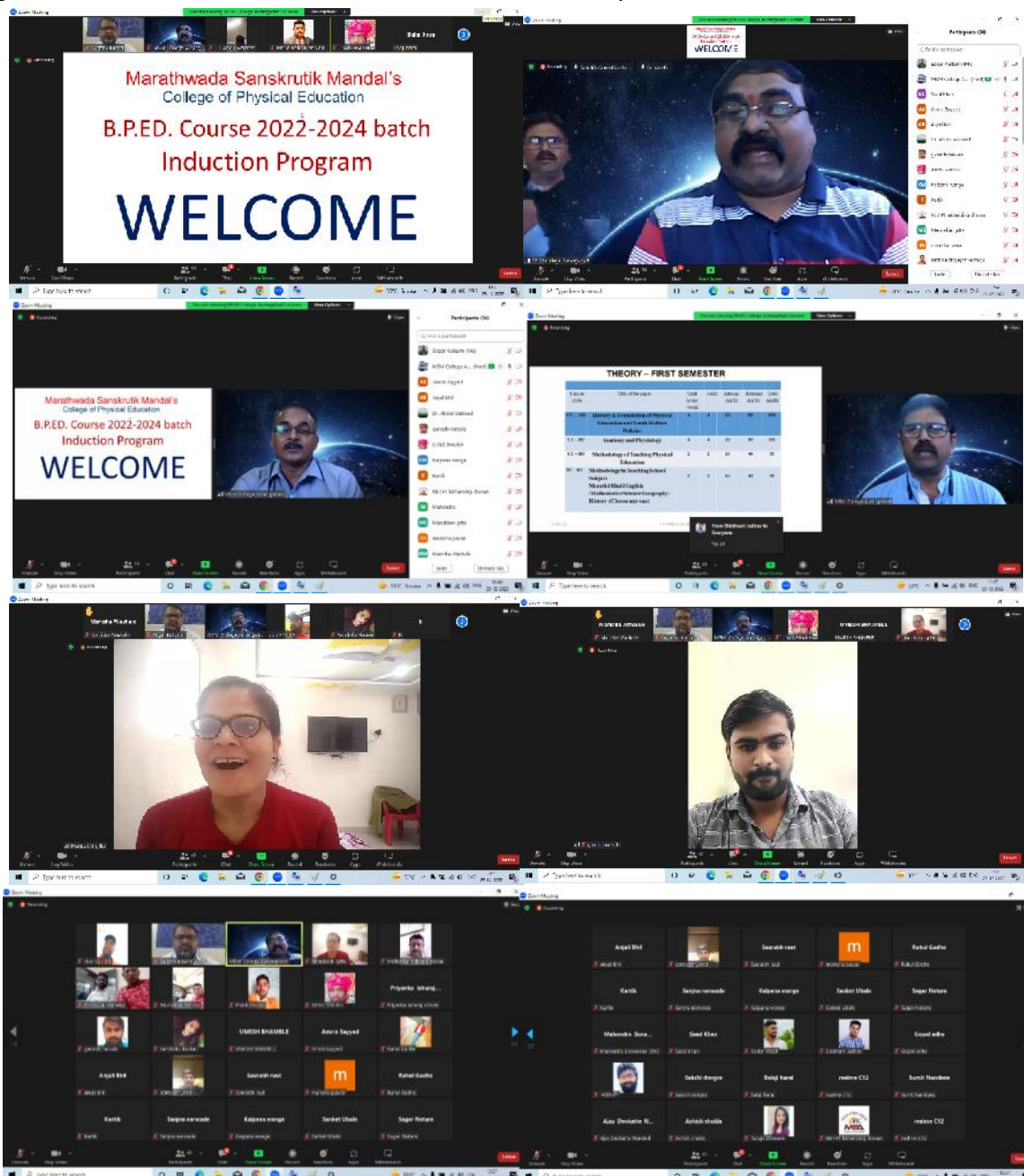

### 3. Saturday, 14<sup>th</sup> January (Vidyapeeth Namvistar Din):

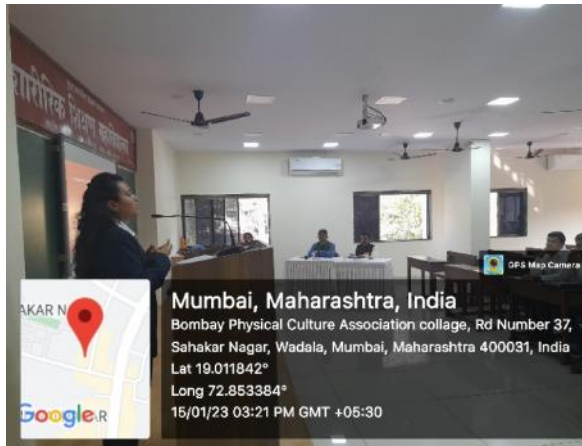

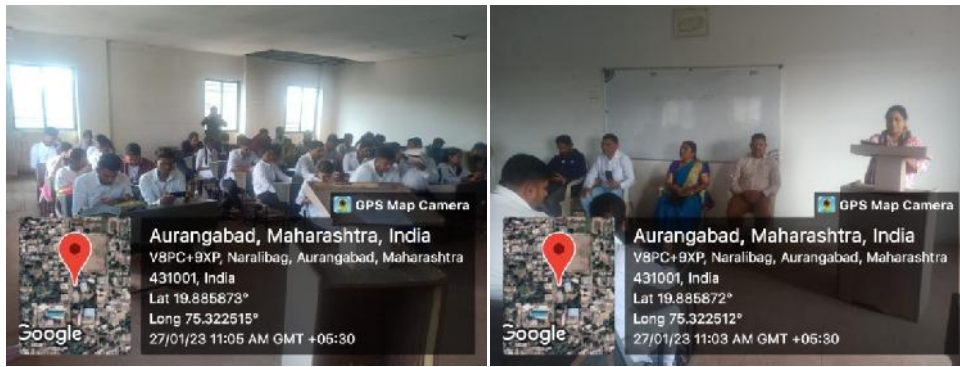

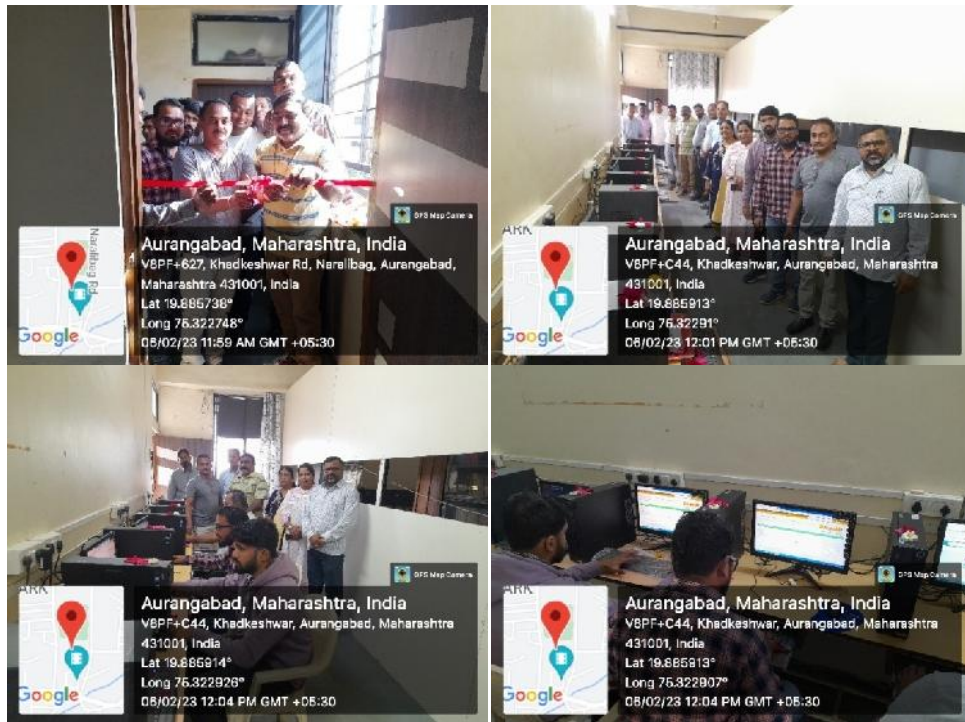
**5. Monday, 6<sup>th</sup> February (SantRavidasMaharajjayanti):**

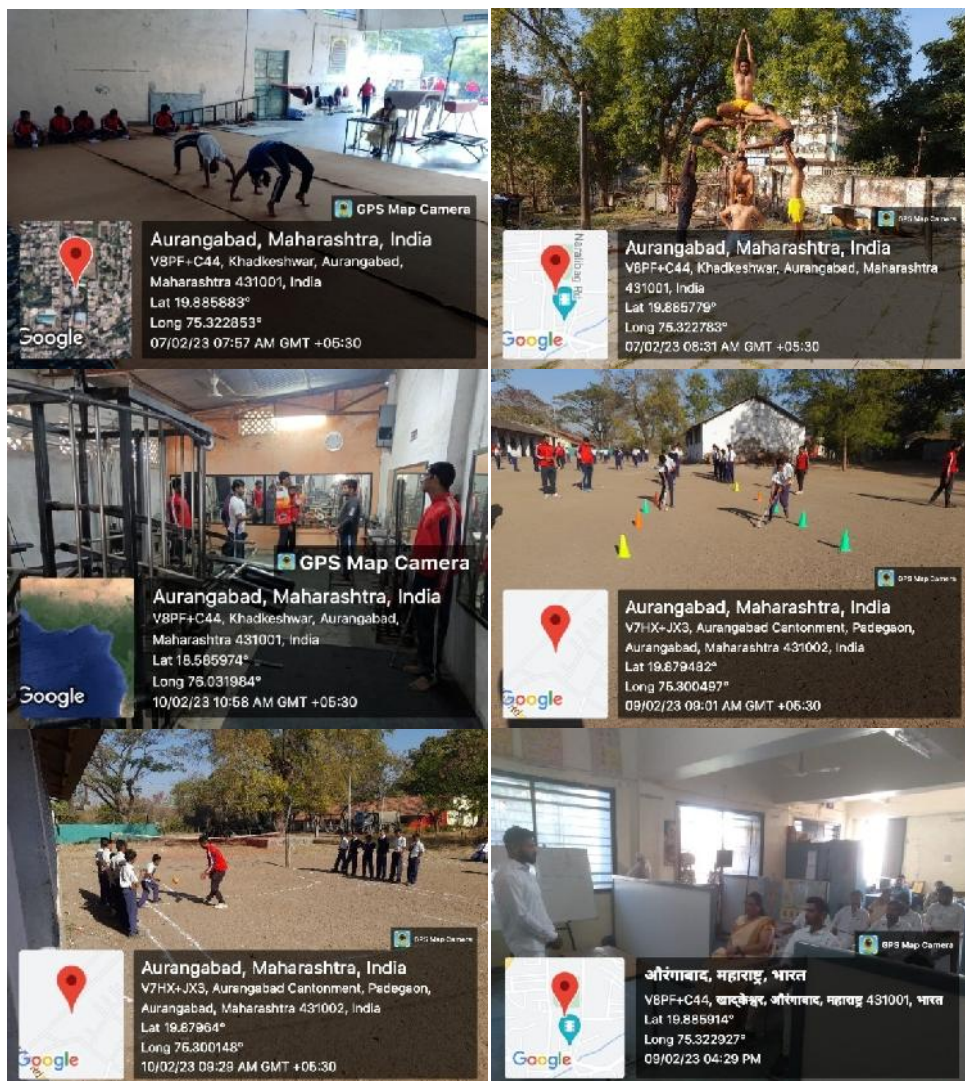
**6. Monday, 6<sup>th</sup> February (Inauguration of updated computer facility):**

Practical exams for III semester were conducted from 7<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> February. That included activities, physical education lessons and internship presentations.



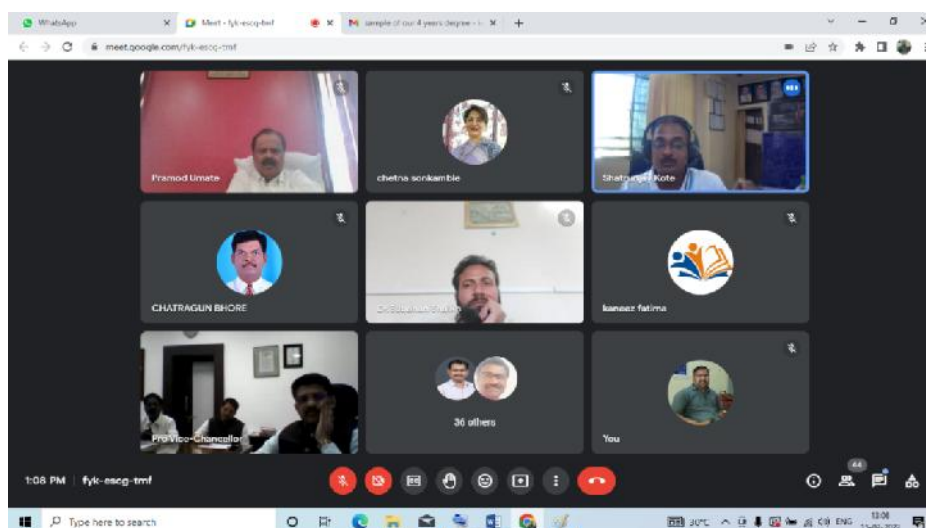
## 8. Saturday, 11<sup>th</sup> February (Departmental research committee):

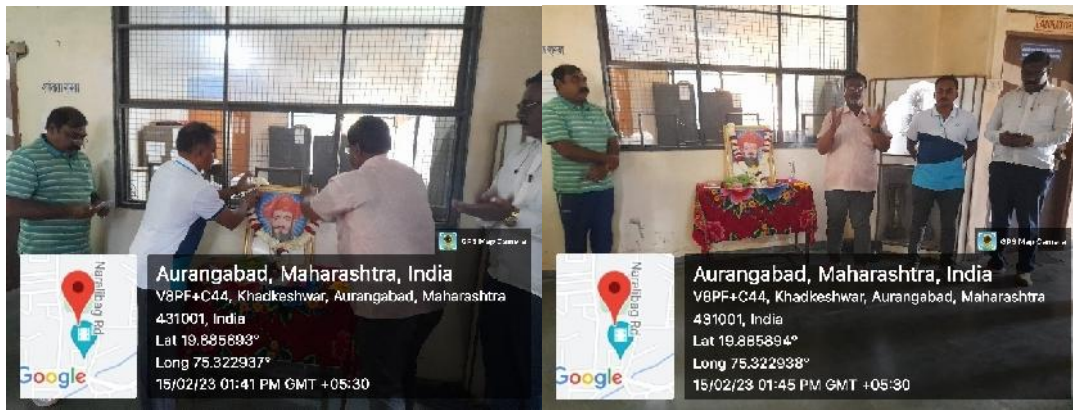
## 9. Wednesday, 15 February (New Education Policy online meeting):

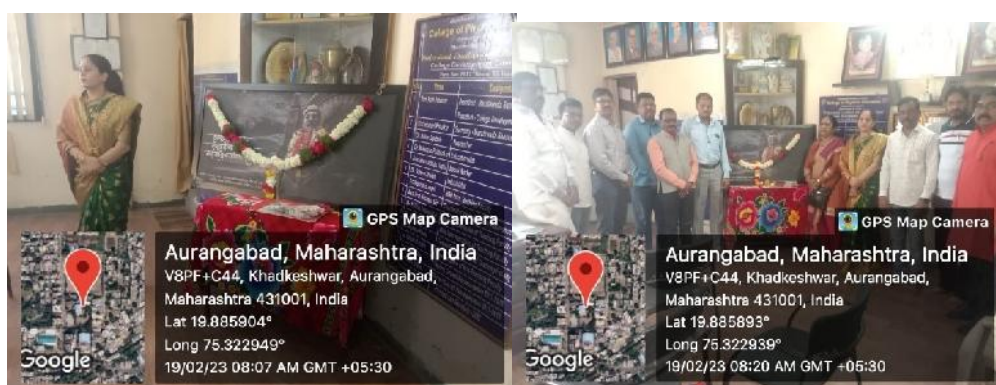
## 10. Wednesday, 15 February (Sant Sewalal Maharaj Jayanti):

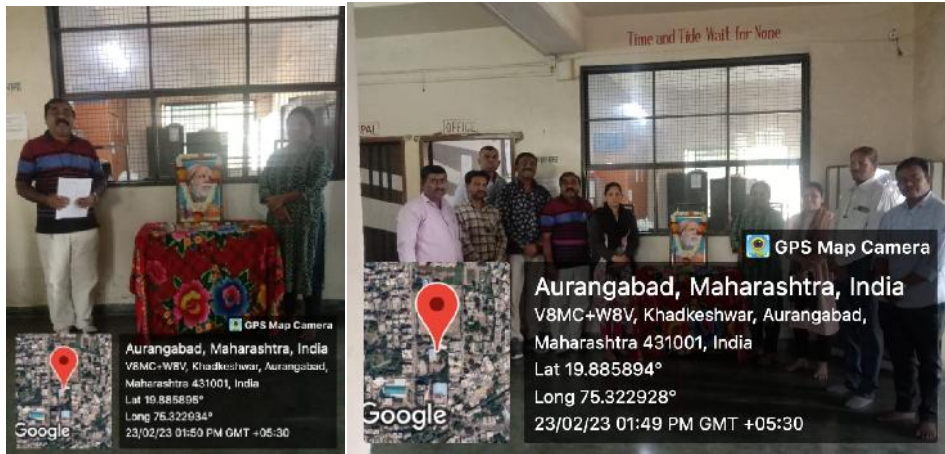
**11. Sunday, 19<sup>th</sup> February ( Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Jayanti):**

**14. Monday, 27<sup>th</sup> February (Marathi Bhasha Din):**

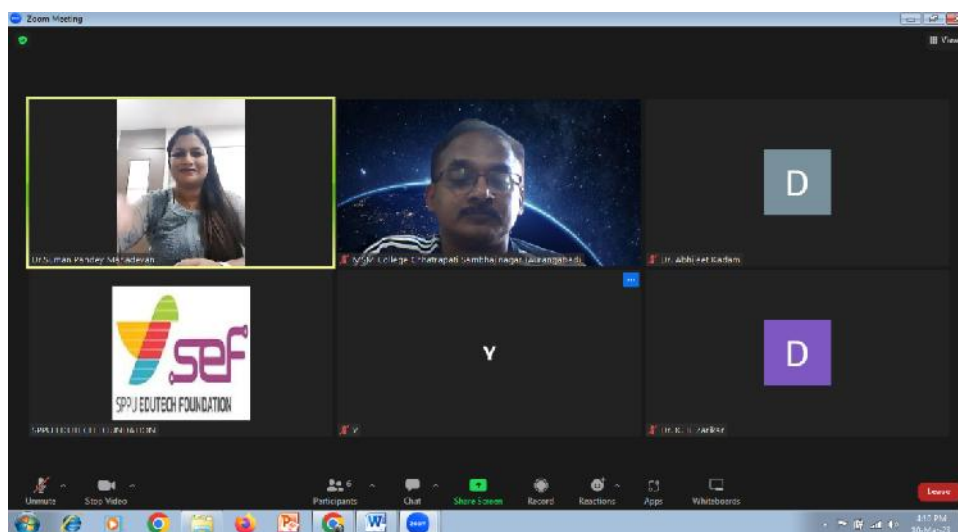

Board of studies of Savitribai Phule Pune University was organized via online mode. Principal Prof. Shatrunjay Kote being the invited member attended the meeting.



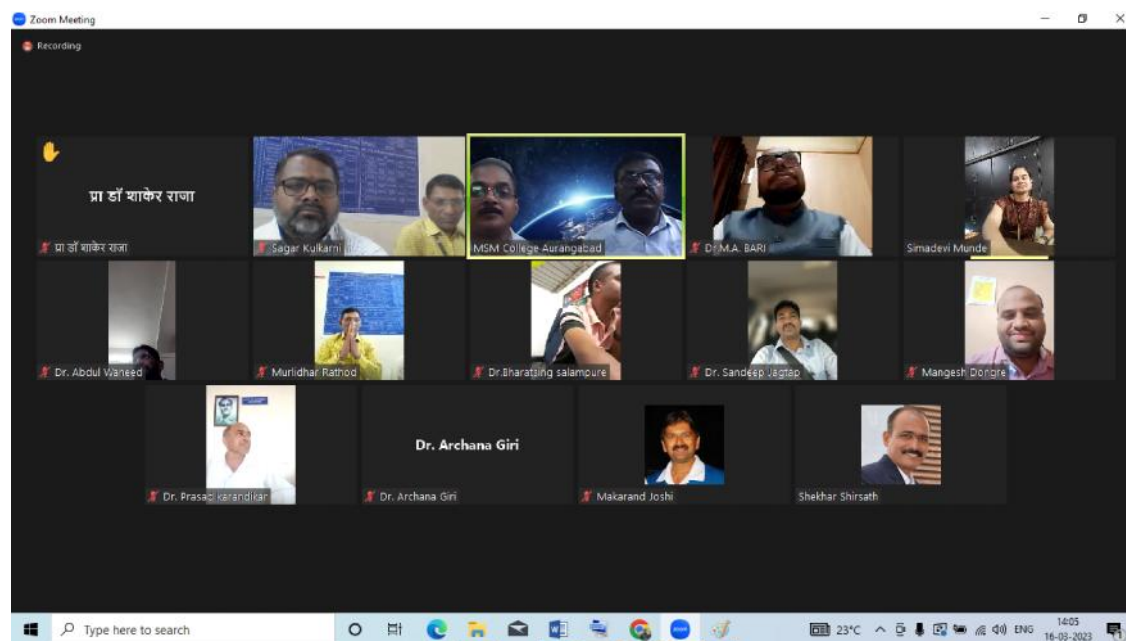
### 2. Sunday, 12<sup>th</sup> March (Felicitation by DattajiBhale Blood Bank):

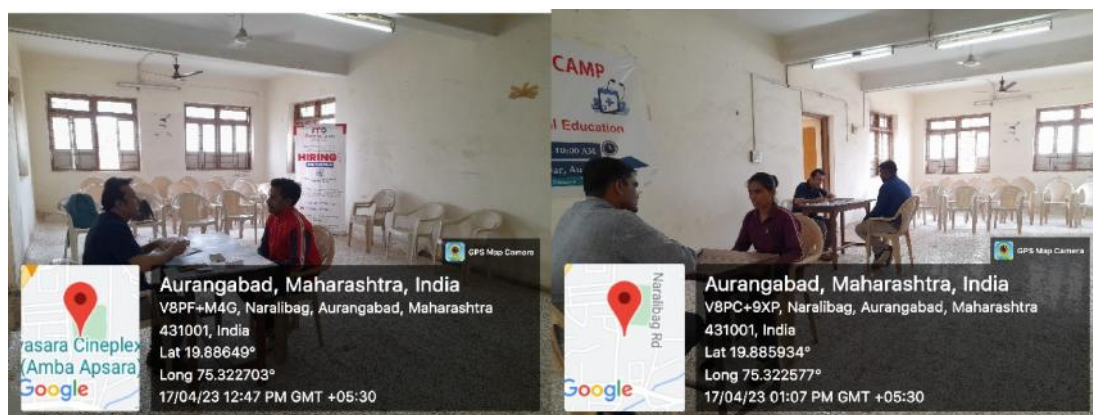
**4. Saturday, 15<sup>th</sup> April (Faculty as guest lecturer):**
