3. Saturday, 23rd July (Lokmanya Bal Gangadhar Tilak Jayanti):

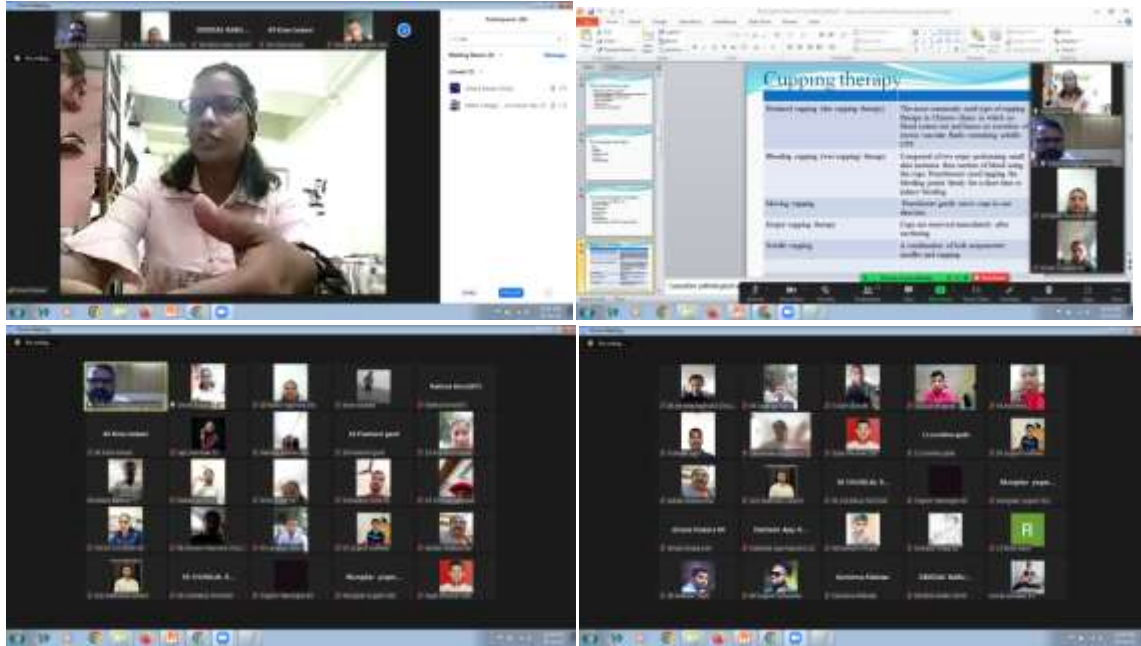

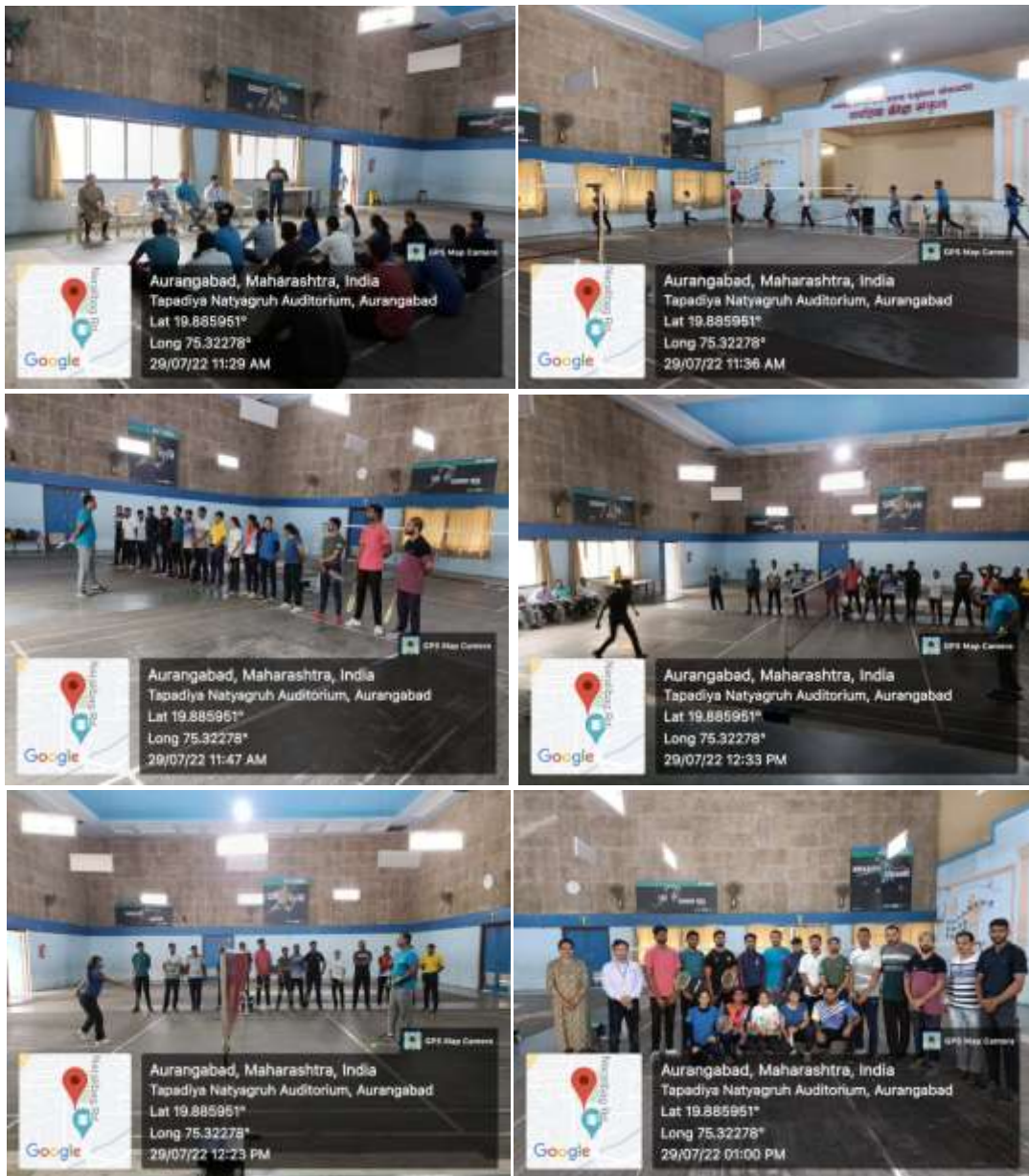
5. Friday, 29th July (Campus cleaning drive):
