2. Sunday and Monday, 6th and 7th November (Educational tour):

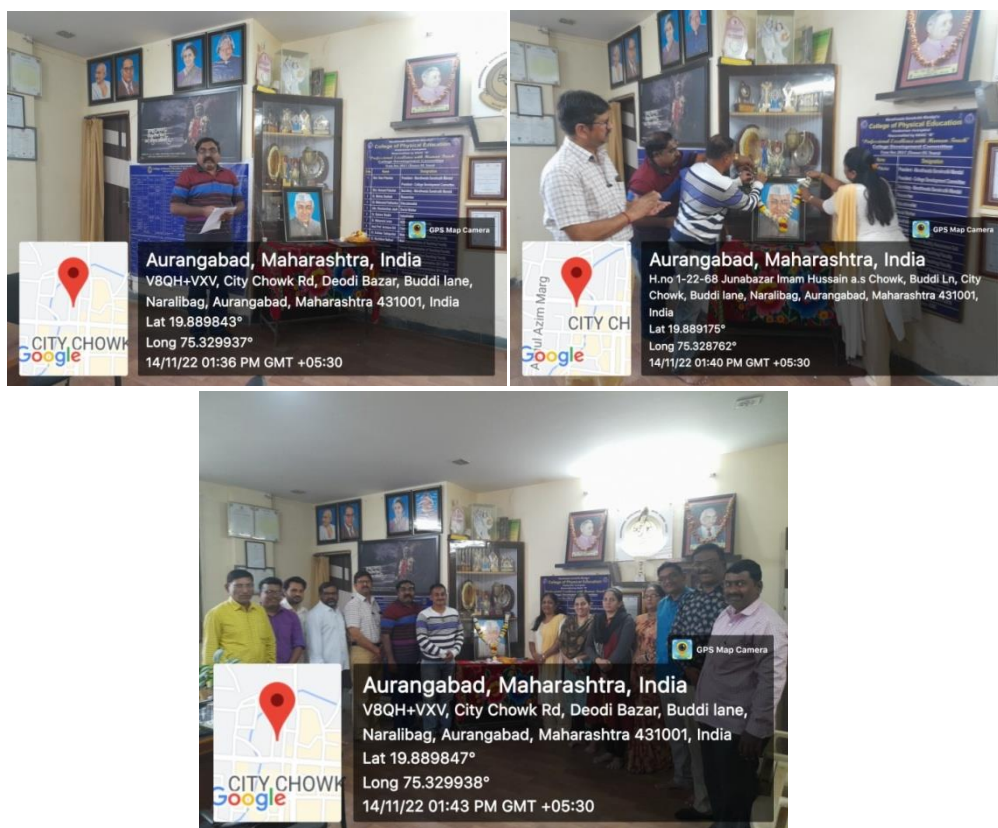

3. Monday, 14th November (Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru and Ustad Lahuji Salve Jayanti):

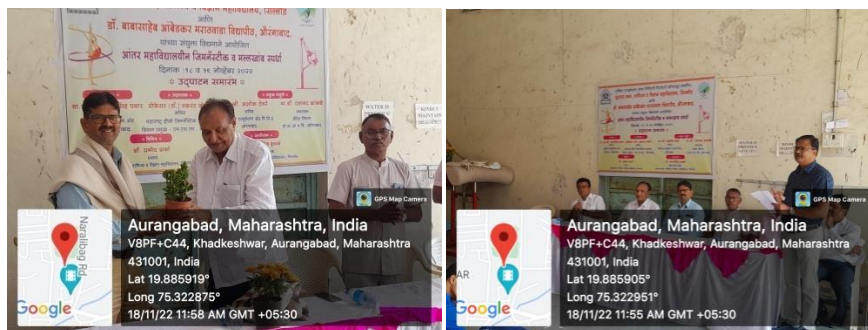

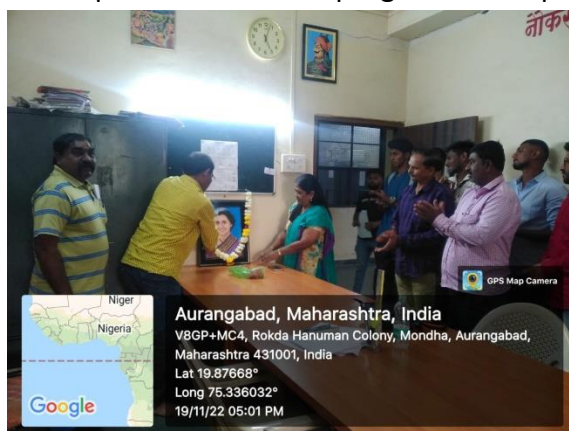
4. Friday, 18th November (Inter-collegiate competition opening ceremony):

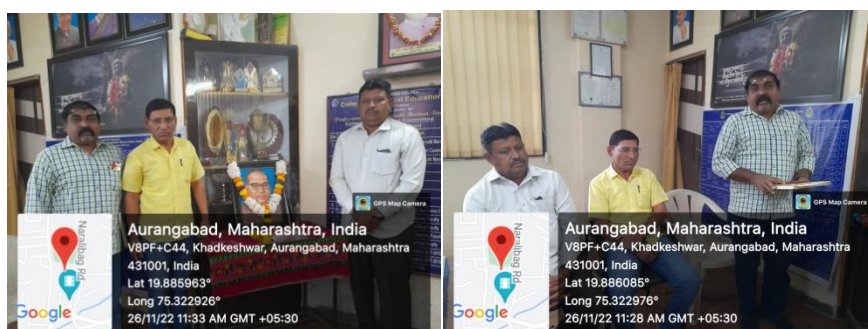
5. Saturday, 19th November (Indira Gandhi Jayanti):

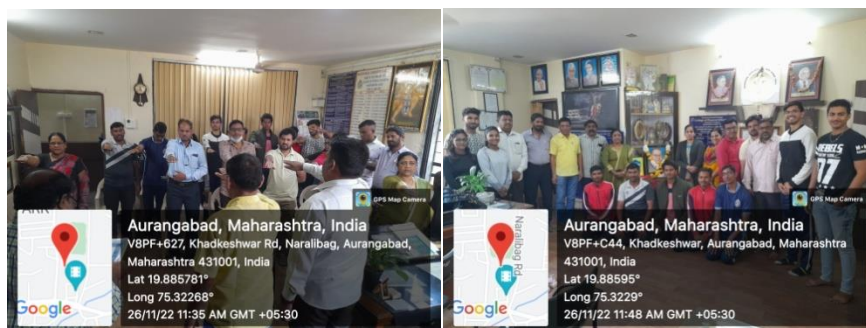
