### 3. Thursday to Sunday, 15<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> September (Practical exams):

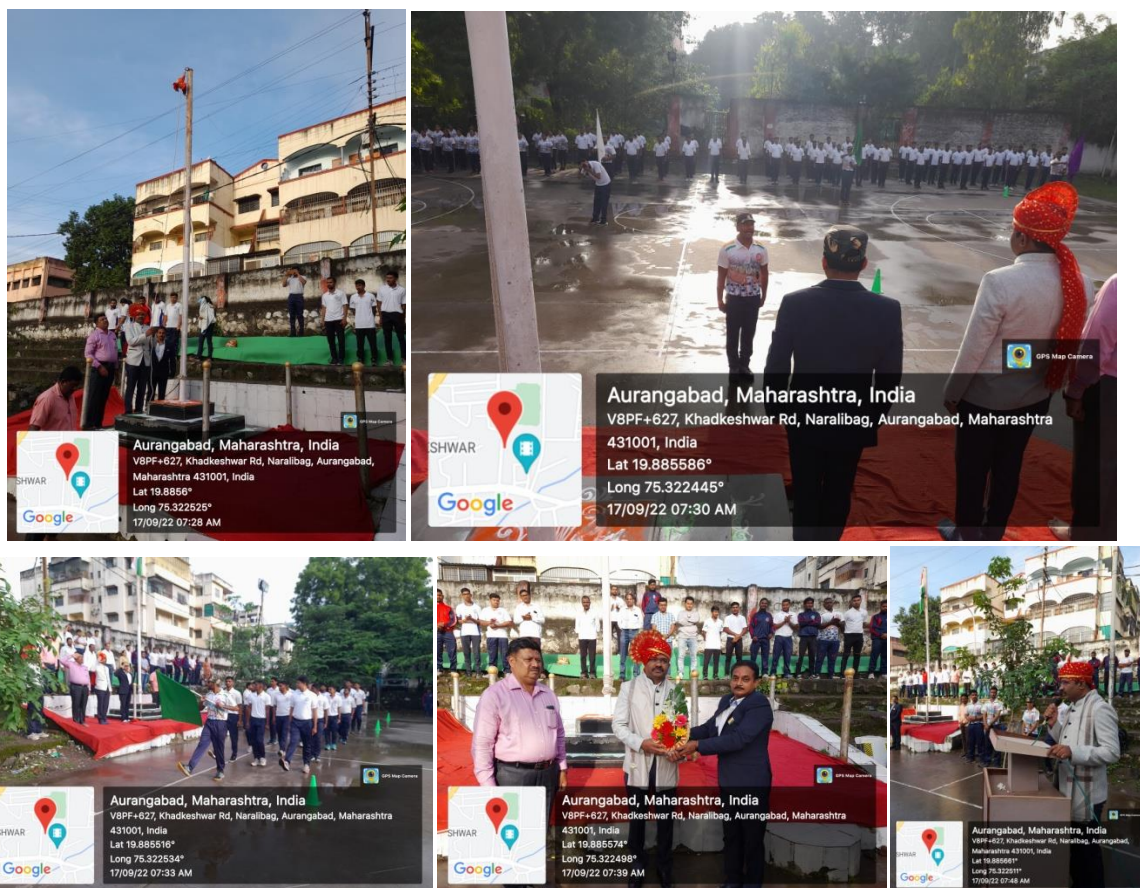

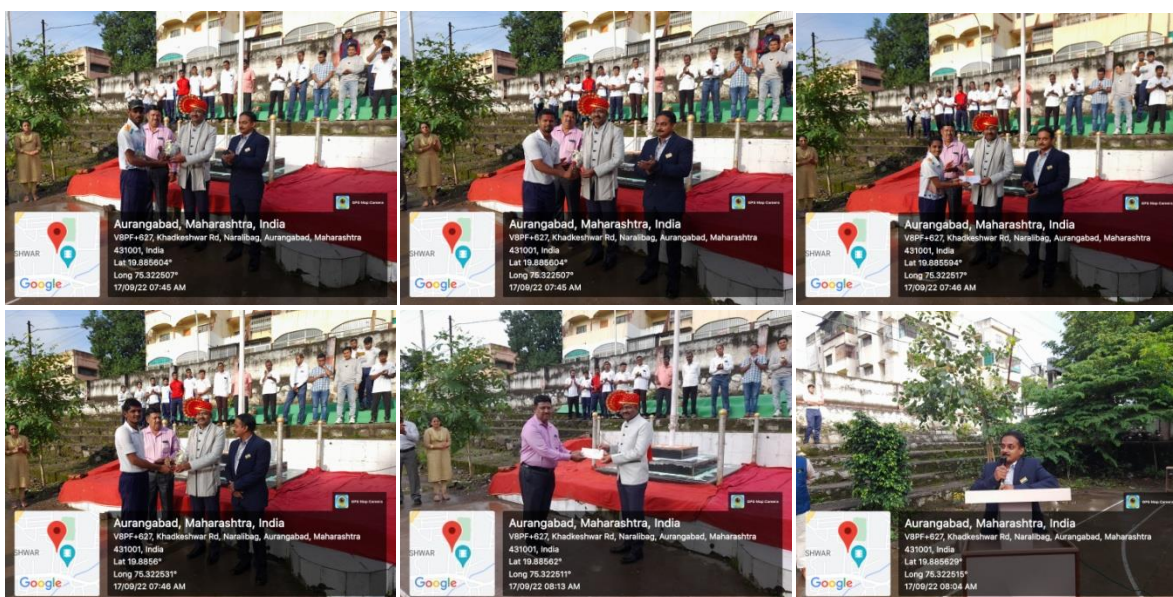

#### 4. Saturday, 17<sup>th</sup> September ( Marathwada liberation day):

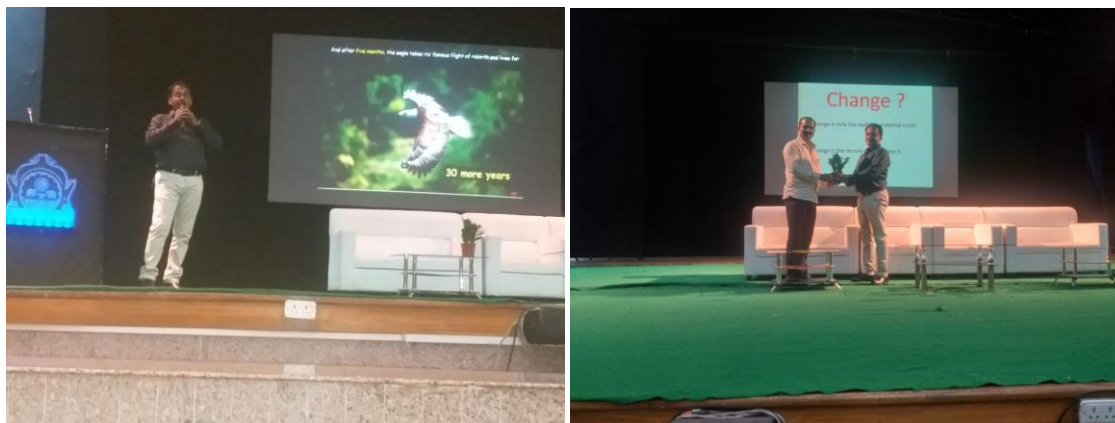
