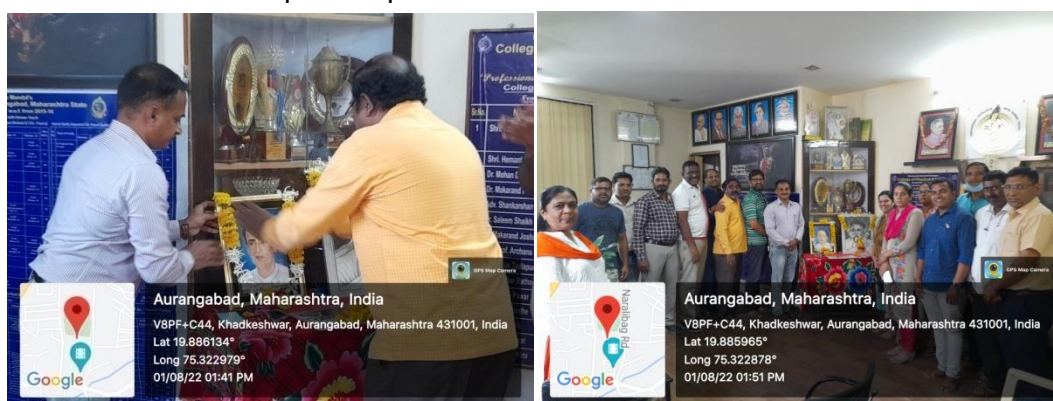


**Marathwada Sanskrutik Mandal's

Monthly report (August 2022)**

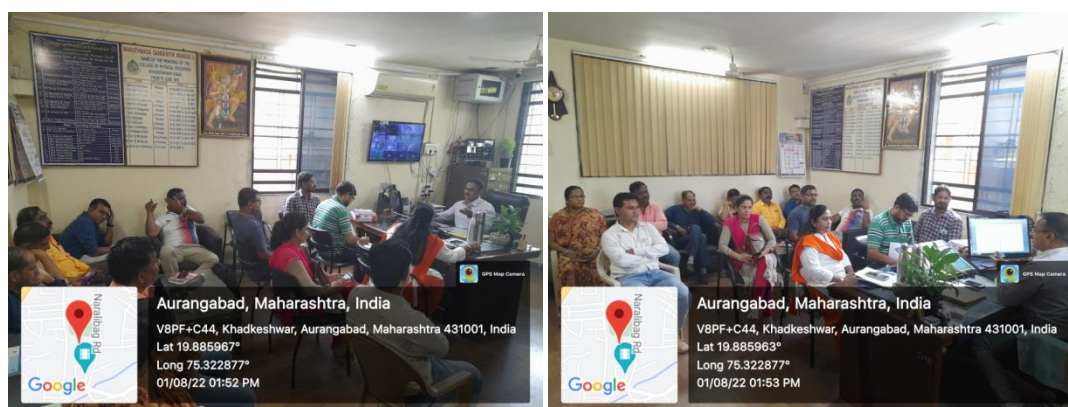
1. Monday, 1st August (Annabhau Sathe Jayantiand Lokmanya Tilak Punyatithi):

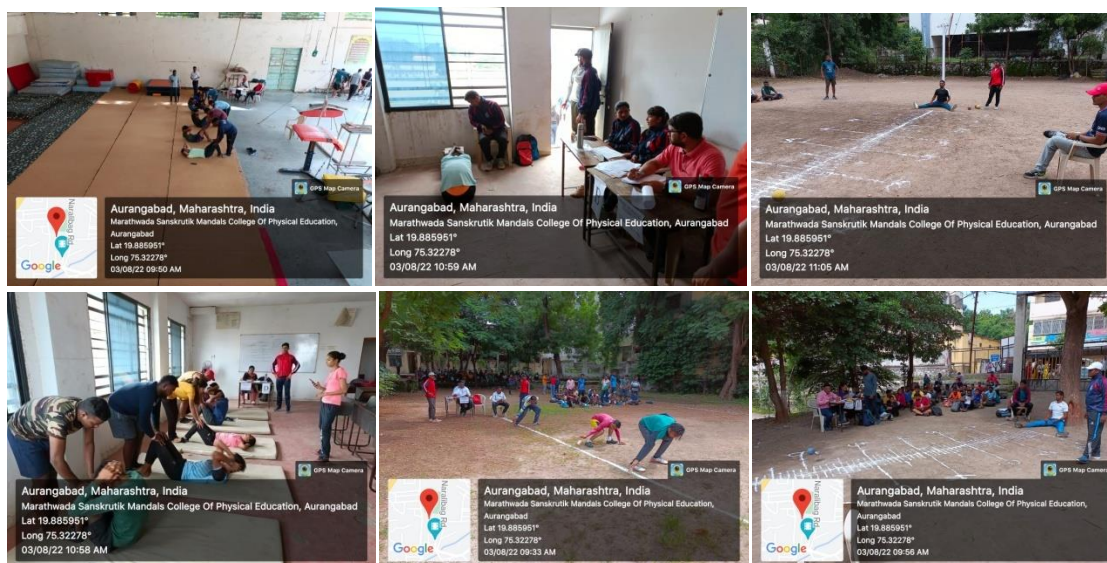
3. Tuesday, 2nd August (Felicitation of Athletic officials):

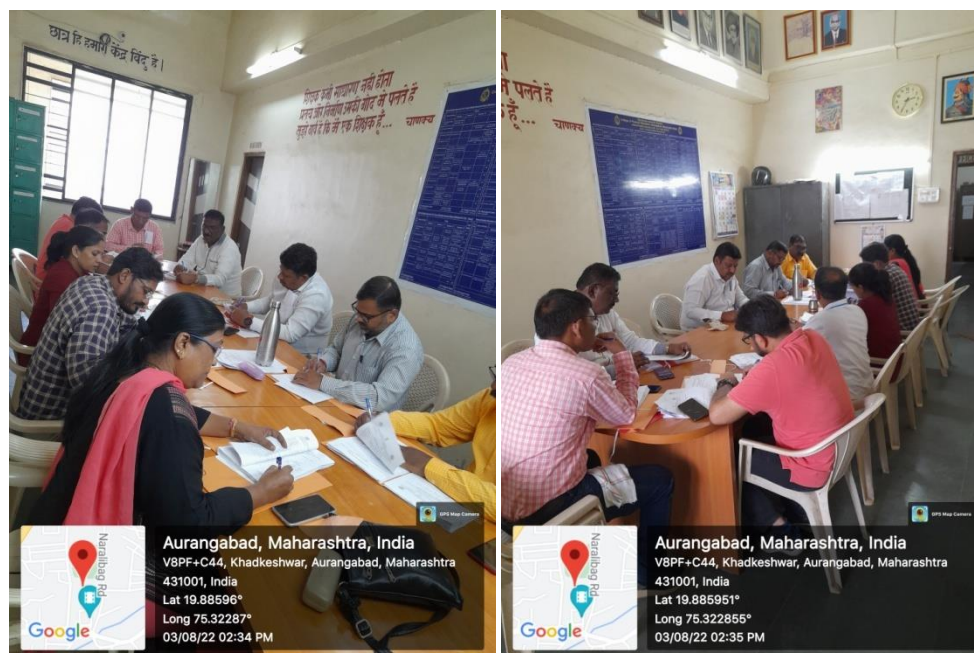
B.P.Ed. students contributed as officials in Aurangabad District Athletics Championship held on 31st July. They were felicitated in college campus for their active participation.

5. Friday, 5th August (Volleyball workshop):

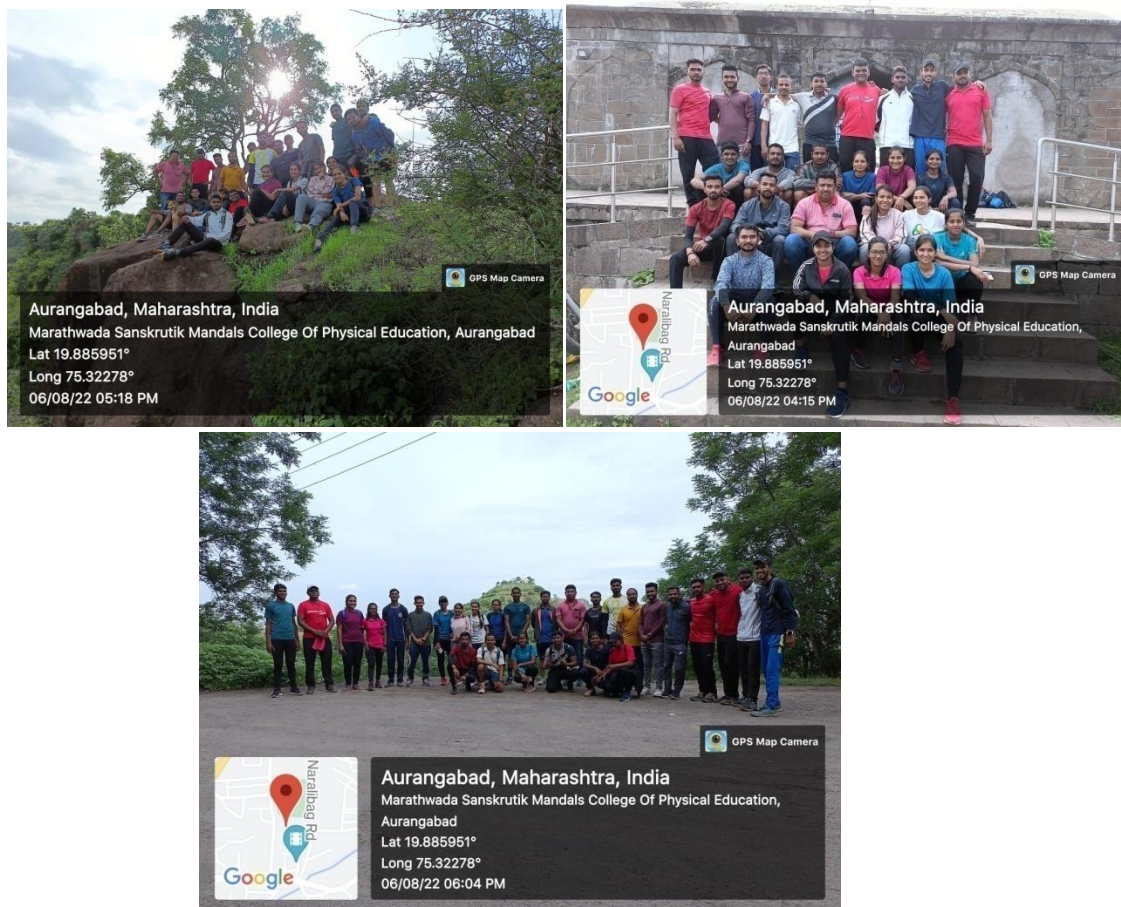

4. **Saturday, 13th August:** Faculty members, non teaching staff members and students hoisted the national flag to mark the 'har ghar tiranga' campaign.

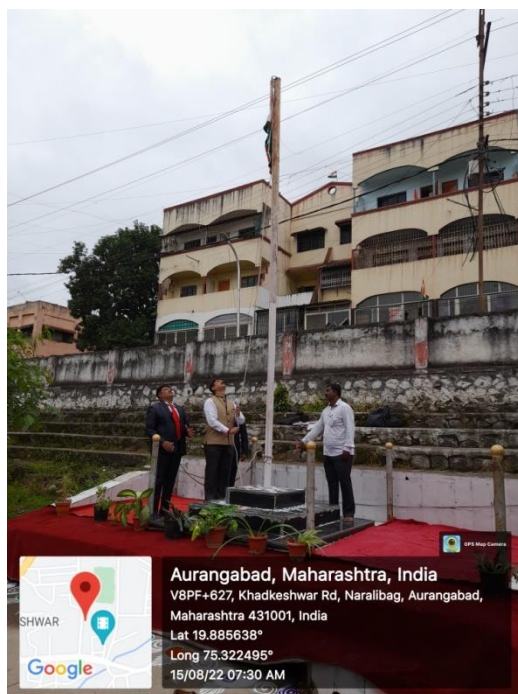

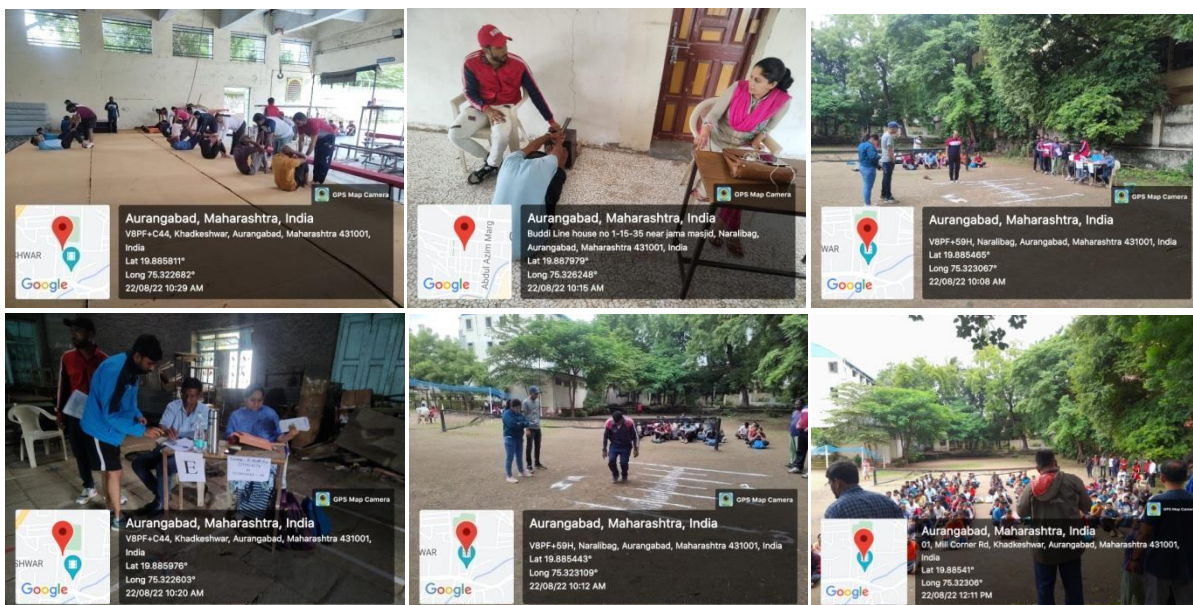

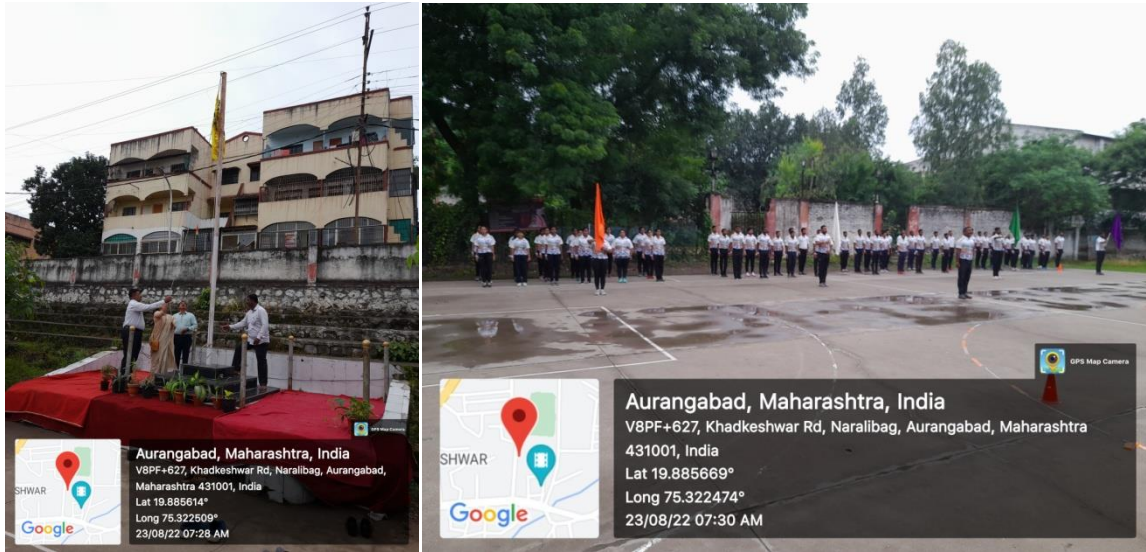
9. Monday, 22nd August (M.P.Ed. CET):

M.P.Ed. CET was conducted as per the directions by the state government CET cell from 7:00 am. to 3:00 pm.



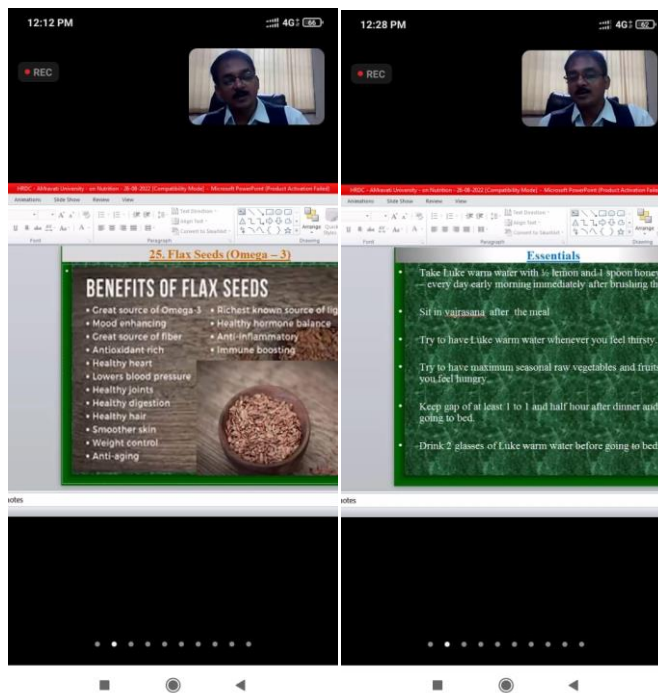
10. Tuesday 23rd August (University Foundation day):

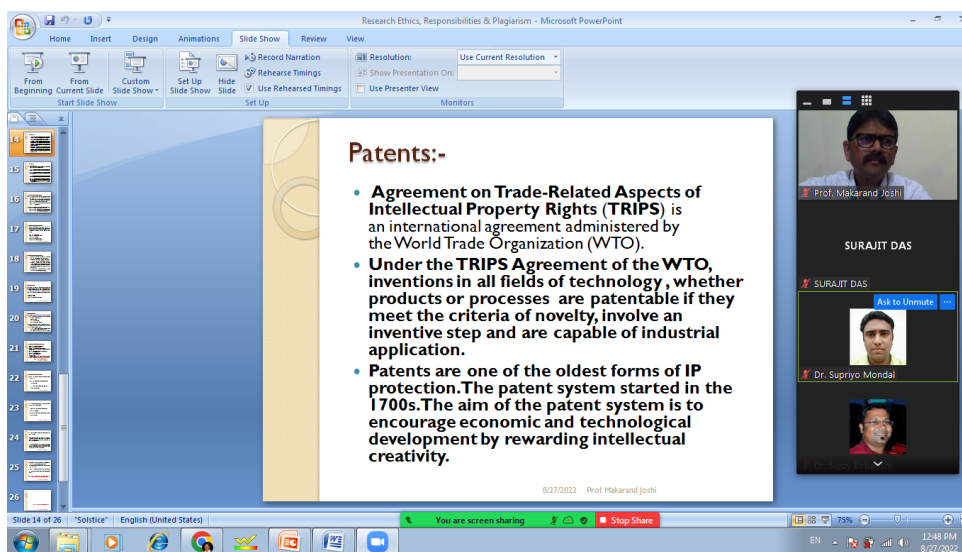
11. Friday, 26th August (Faculty as resource person):
