### 3. Thursday, 15<sup>th</sup> June (College reopening day) :

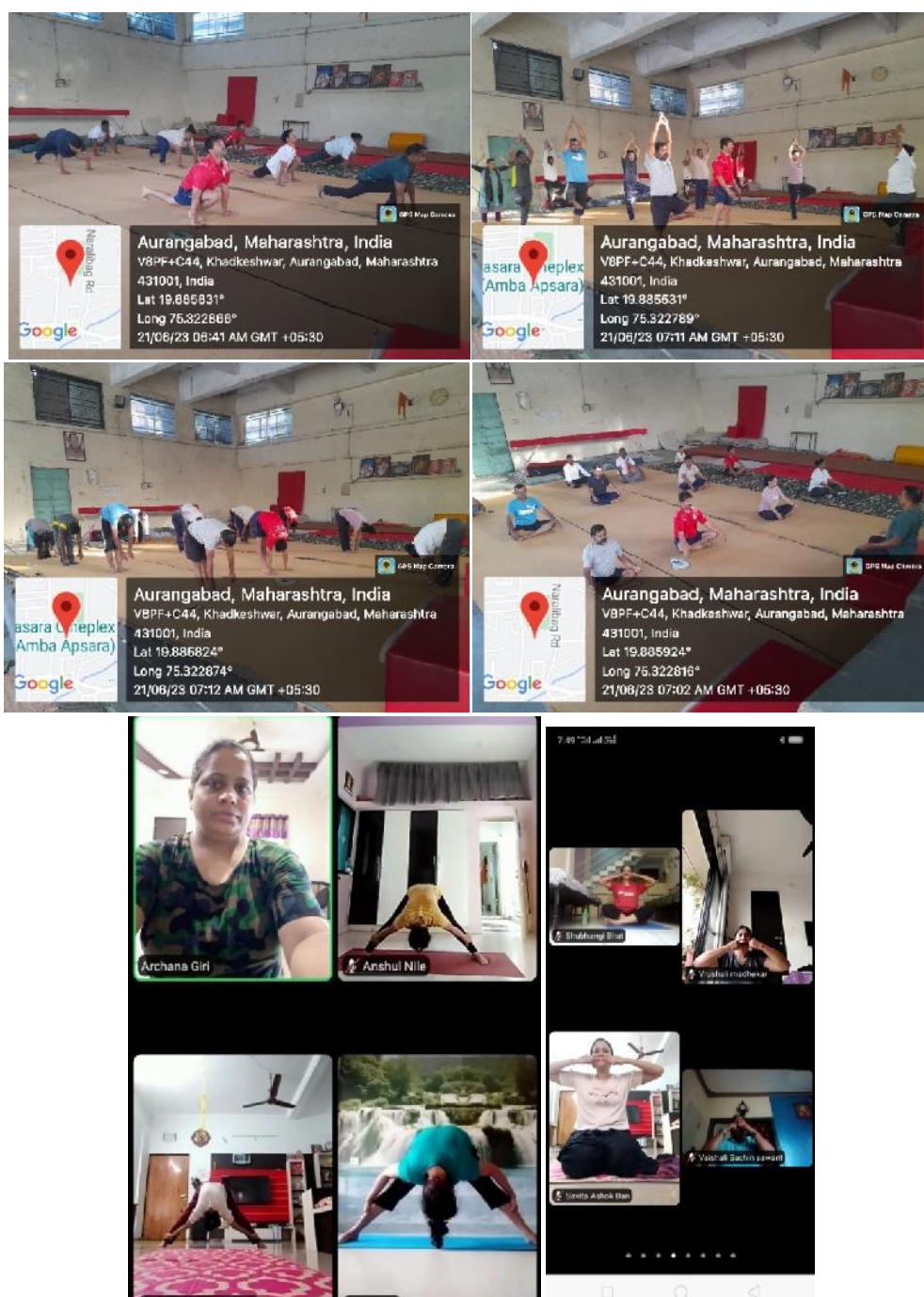

### 4. Saturday, 12<sup>th</sup> August (Physical education Practice teaching):

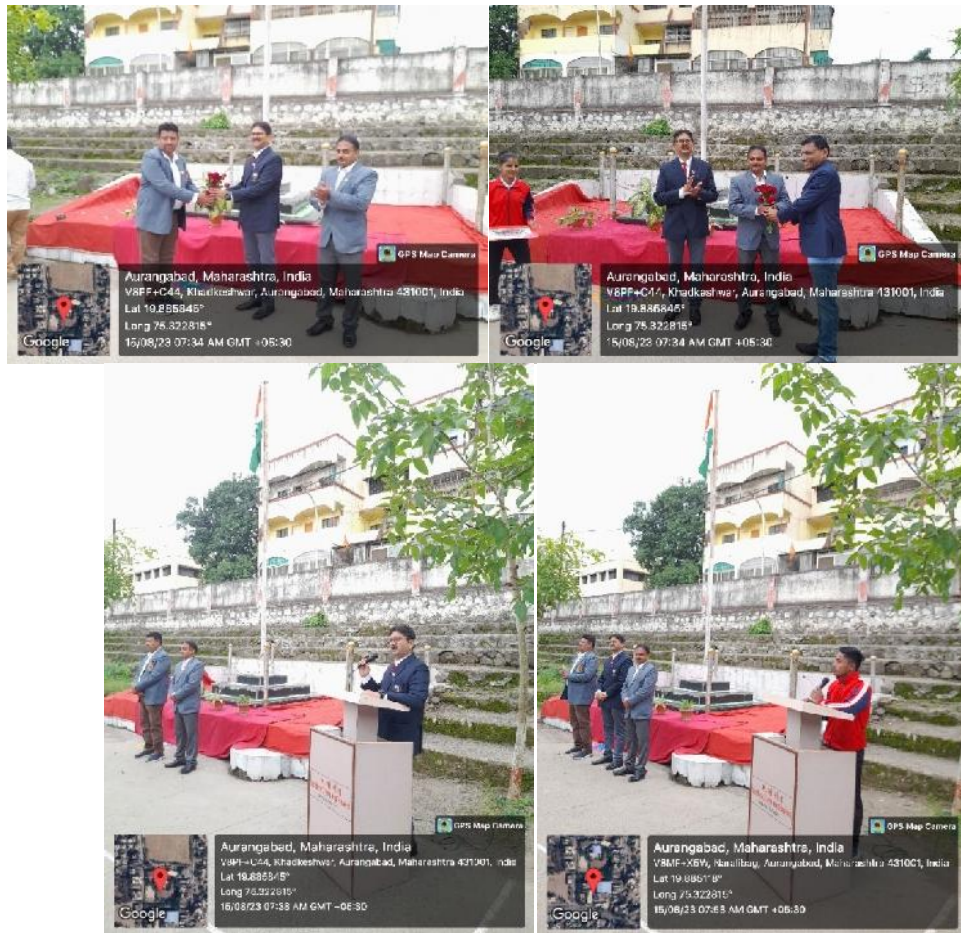

## 7. Wednesday & Thursday, 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> October (Yuva mahotsav participation):

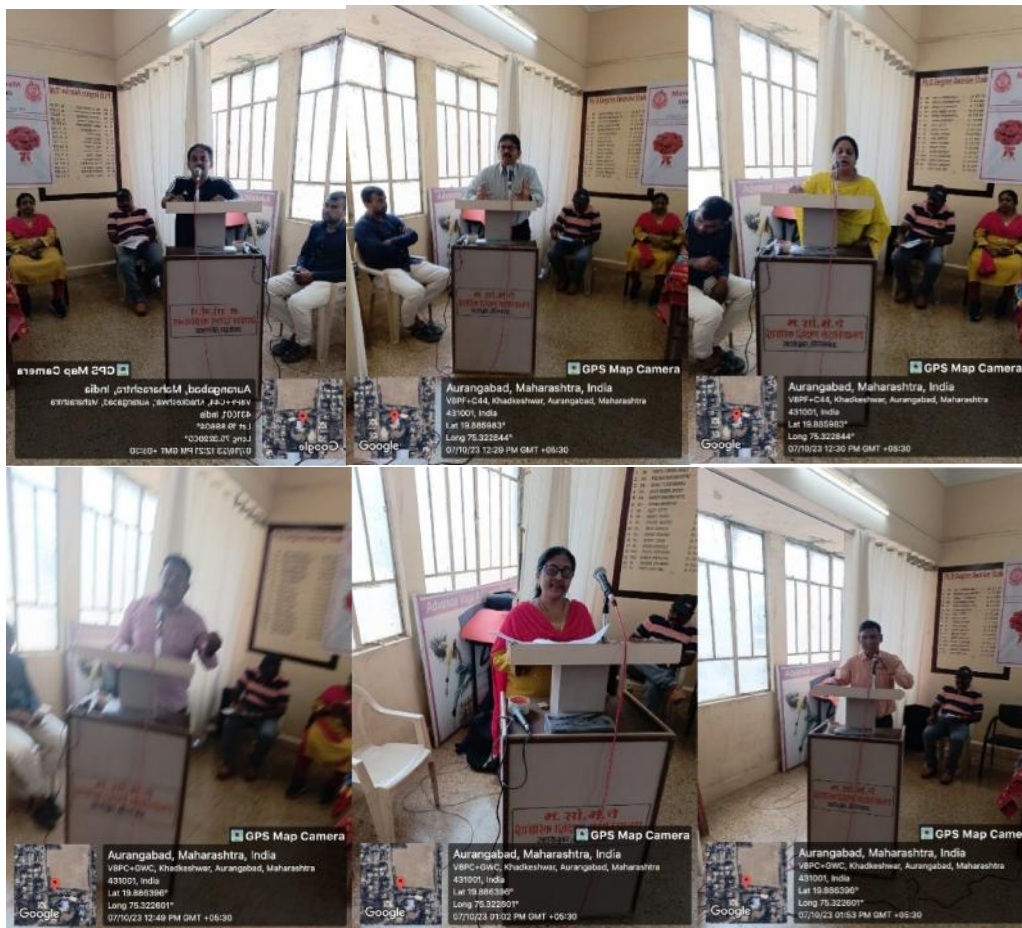

**4. Friday, 12<sup>th</sup> January (Swami Vivekanand and Ma sahib Jijaujayanti) :**

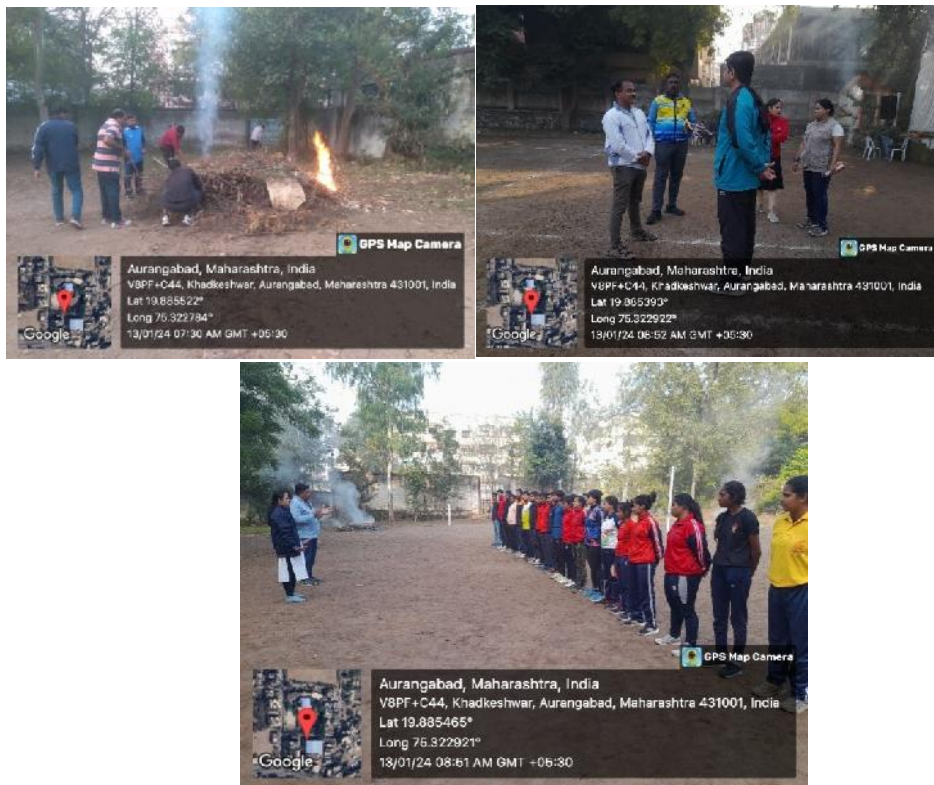

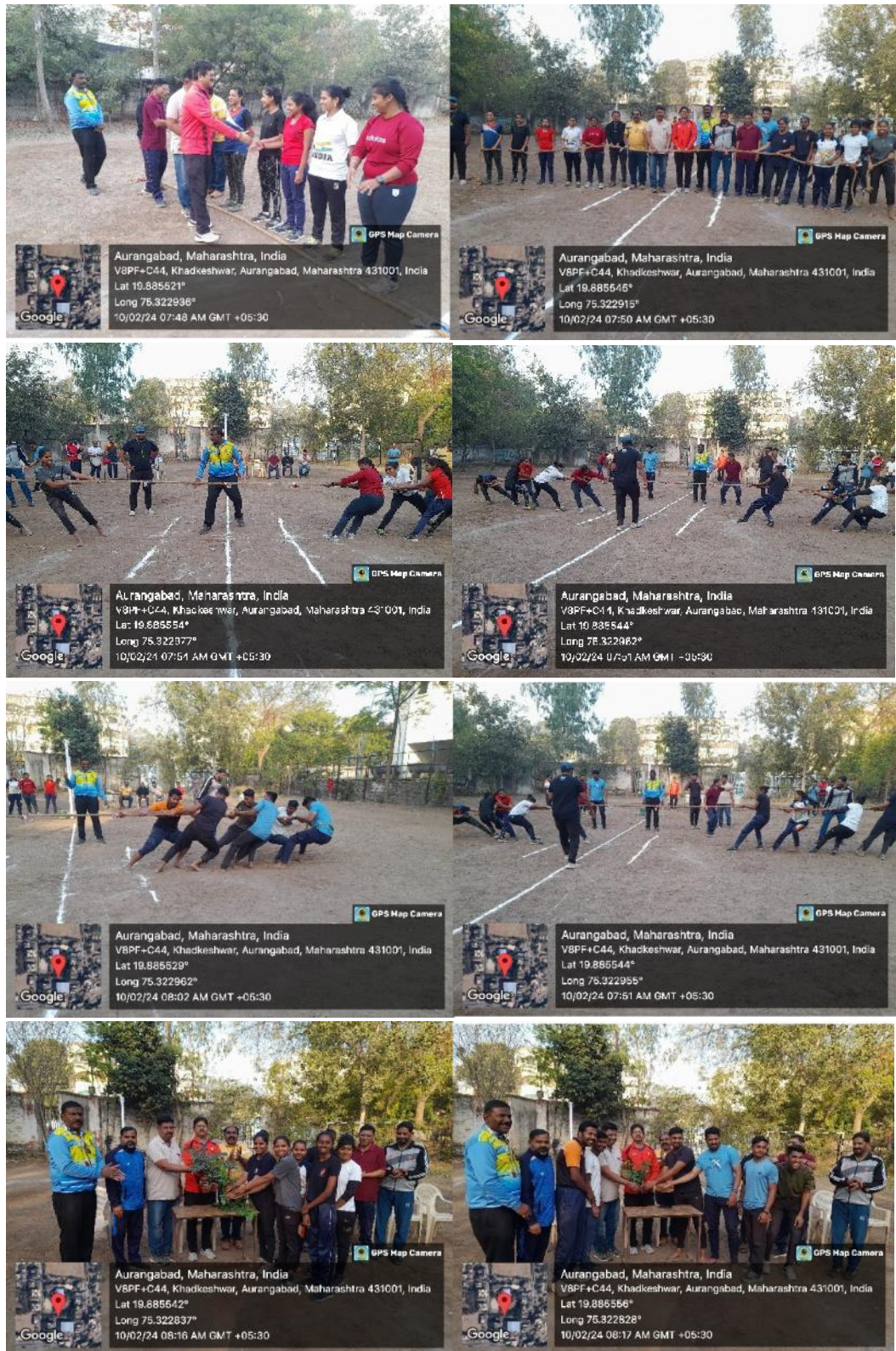
## 3. Thursday, 8<sup>th</sup> February (Workshop on green field):

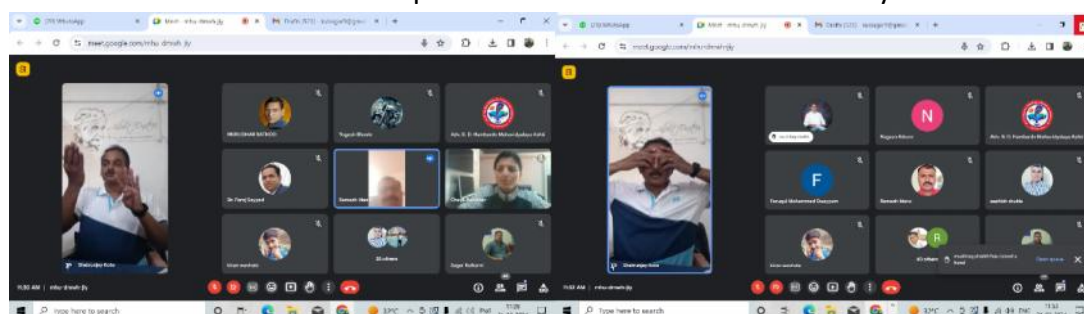
