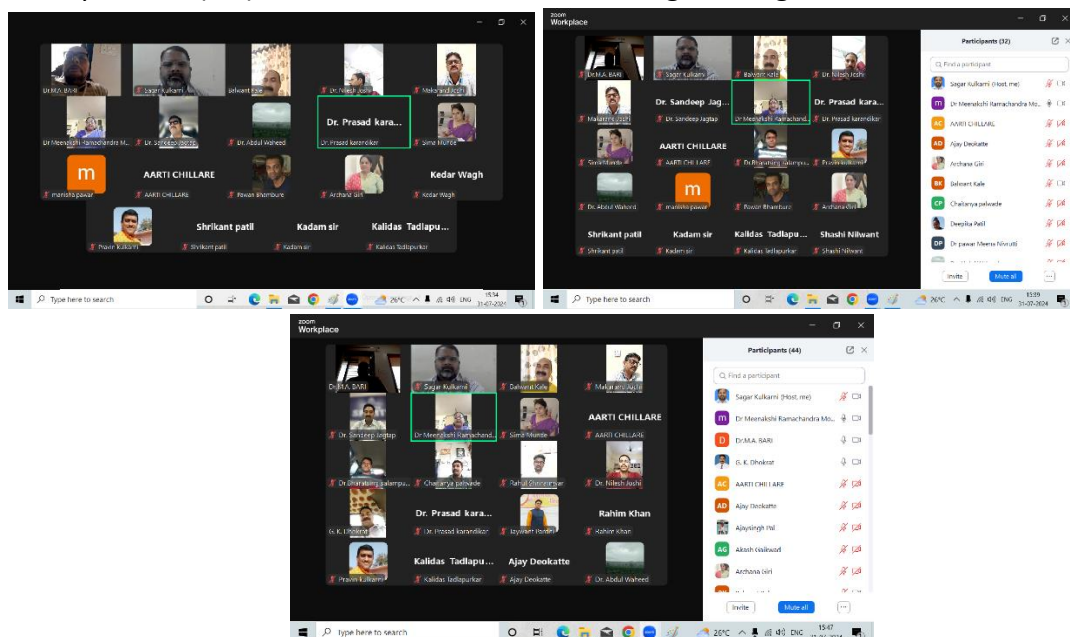
8. Saturday, 27th July (Demo lessons on field):

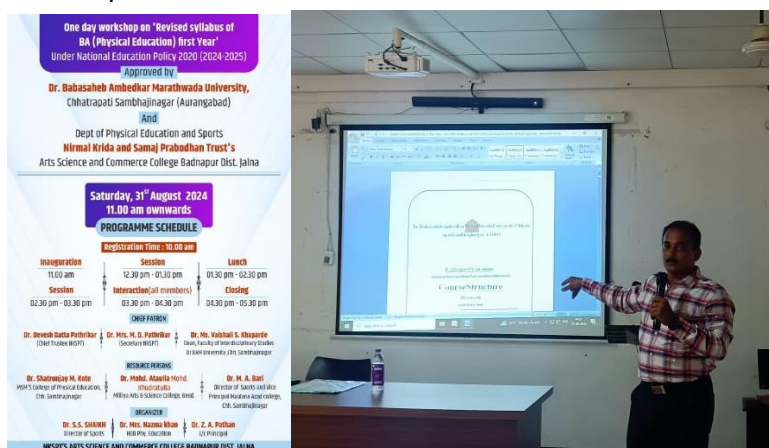
Thursday, 29th August (Faculty as chief guest):

Monthly report (September 2024)

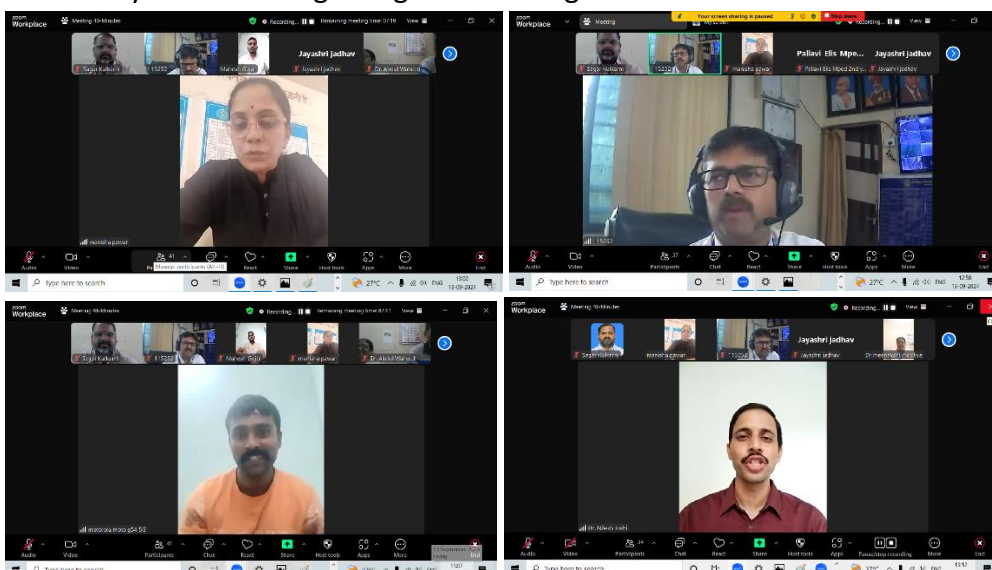
1. Thursday, 5th September (Sarvapalli Radhakrishnan birth anniversary):

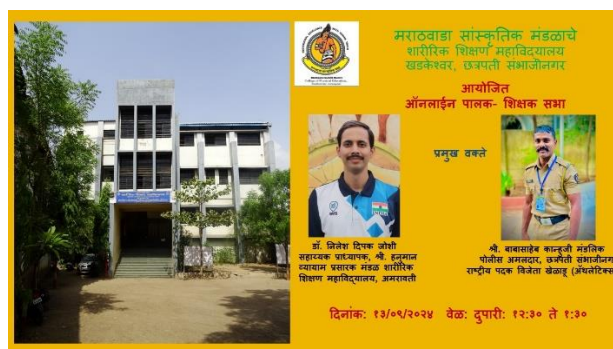

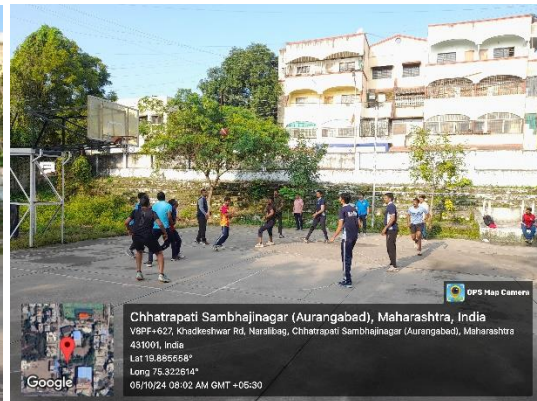
6. Wednesday, 2nd October (Gandhi Jayanti):

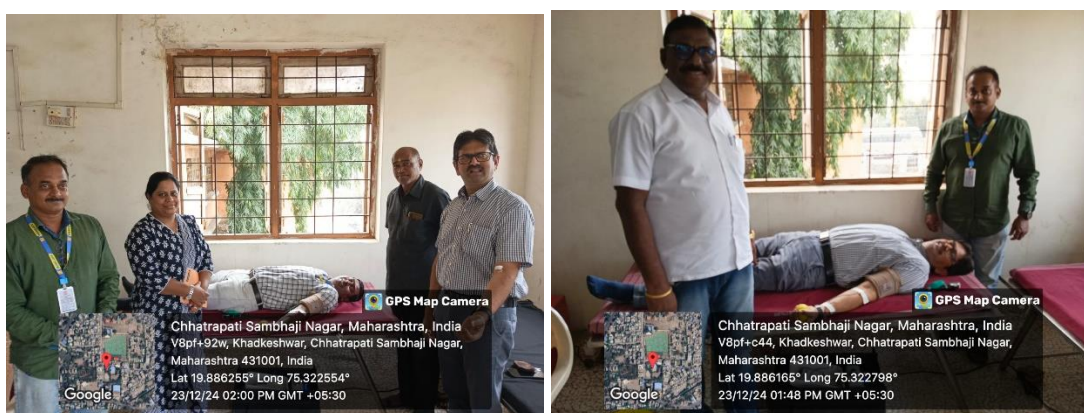
Monthly report (December2024)

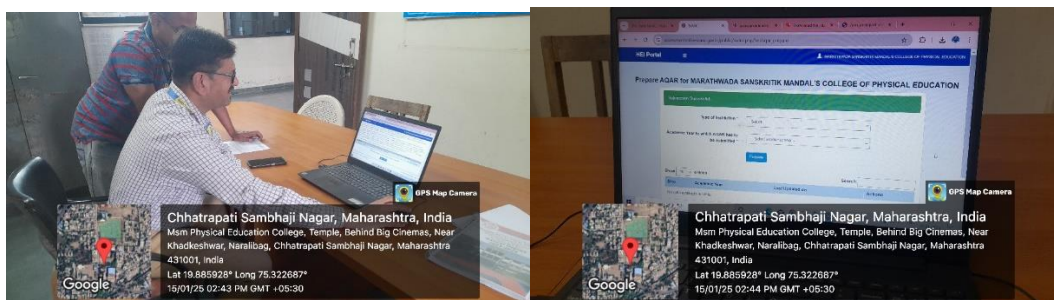
4. Wednesday, 15th January (State Sports Day):

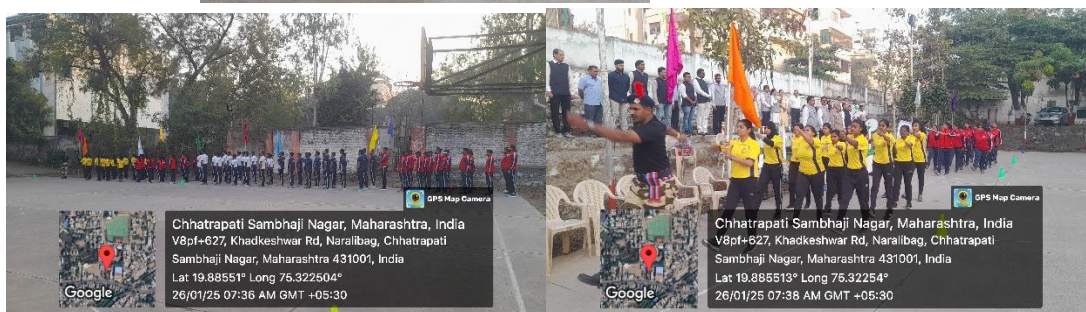
5. Wednesday, 15th January (AQAR Submission):

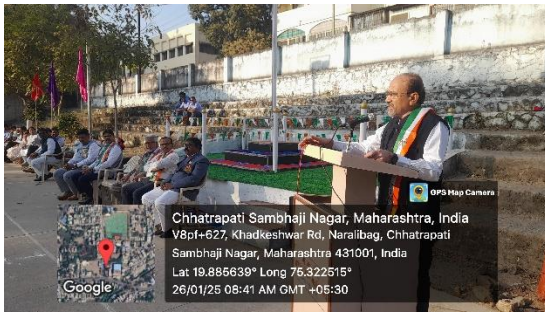
